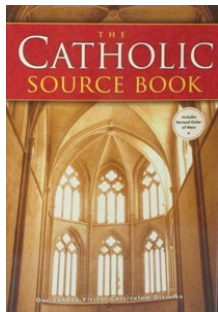

The most commonly accepted list is as follows: January – *Holy Childhood*, February – *Holy Family*, March – *Saint Joseph*, April – *Holy Cross*, May – *Blessed Virgin Mary*, June – *Sacred Heart*, July – *Precious Blood*, August – *Blessed Sacrament*, September – *Seven Sorrows of Mary*, October – *the Holy Rosary*, November – *Holy Souls*, December – *Immaculate Conception*. Many different religious Orders also have their own Month's Dedication.
