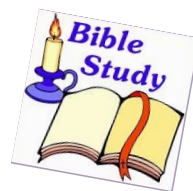

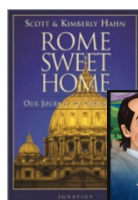

DID YOU KNOW.....

that the Season of Advent is very much a “Marian Season”? Ours is a very “Marian” Parish, with many visible signs of our great devotion to Our Lady.

The church bells sound forth from the “Ave Maria Tower” (a gift of the Knights of Columbus), while the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe graces the south façade of the church, as well as the shrine located on the west end of Kino Hall, depicting Saint Juan Diego kneeling before the Apparition. Another image of Our Lady of Guadalupe is enshrined above the entrance of Madonna Hall. A beautiful statue of Our Lady of Grace stands in the Memorial Prayer Garden, and many make visits to the Shrine to the Holy Family in the south parking lot.

In the Gathering Room (narthex) of the church is the image of Our Lady Who Unties Knots. The special significance of this image of our Lady, made enormously popular by the devotion to her by Pope Francis, is that ours was only the second dedicated parish shrine to Her in the United States! Pick up a ‘holy card’ and pray the prayer written for our Parish’s use! When you enter the church itself, you see that a Rosary ‘railing’ in cast stone binds the whole Sanctuary, a detail repeated in the Divine Mercy Chapel. The principal image of Our Lady in the church is the Madonna and Child carved in Oberammergau for the original church, enshrined at the front of the Sanctuary. The full-sized image of Our Lady of Guadalupe on the first niche on the east side is paralleled by an image of Our Lady of Mount Carmel on the west side. At the top of the staircase in the balcony is a beautiful image of Our Lady of the Apocalypse, painted by one of our parishioners. In the Divine Mercy Chapel are located the images of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Our Lady of La Vang, and Our Lady of Czestochowa – each important to our Filipino, Vietnamese, and Polish communities!

We are a “Marian” Parish, and we will honor Our Lady’s Immaculate Conception with Masses on Wednesday 7 December, at 7:00 PM at Good Shepherd Mission, and on Thursday, 8 December, with Masses at 9:00 AM (livestreamed), 12:05 Noon, and 7:00 PM.

On Sunday, 11 December, we will honor Our Lady of Guadalupe, with a Dinner at 4:00 PM, Procession at 6:00 PM followed by the multi-lingual Rosary, with Mass at 7:00, with the Mañanitas immediately following the Mass.

Thank you -- for your love for God, your love for Our Lady, and, for your love for your Church!

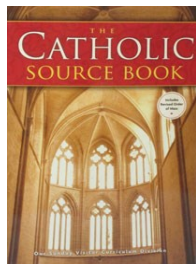

This Week's Question: "What is 'Gaudete Sunday'?"

The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What are the 'O Antiphons'?" These ancient prayers of Advent are the antiphons (verses) for the Gospel canticle, and Evening Prayer of the Church, during the last seven days leading up to Christmas. Each antiphon includes an Old Testament title for the Messiah, a praise for the Lord's saving action, and finally, a petition – a good model for composing personal prayers! The seven 'titles' are: O Wisdom, O Lord of Israel, O Flower of Jesse's Stem, O Key of David, O Radiant Dawn, O King of the Nations, and, O Emmanuel. The hymn "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" is the best-known musical setting of the 'O Antiphons'!

POPE BENEDICT XVI CALLS PIPE ORGAN AN EVANGELIZATION TOOL

On July 7, 2008, Pope Benedict XVI spoke about "that wonderful day, in which I was able to bless the new organ, the 'Benedikt-Orgel,' in the 'Old Chapel' at CASTEL GANDOLFO, Italy.

He said: "I have an indelible memory of how -- in the harmony of that wonderful organ, of the choir ..., and the luminous beauty of the church -- we experienced the joy that comes from God. Not just the 'spark of the gods' of which Schiller speaks, but truly the flame of the Holy Spirit that brought us to feel in our innermost being what we also know from the Gospel of St. John: That he himself is joy. And this joy was communicated to us."

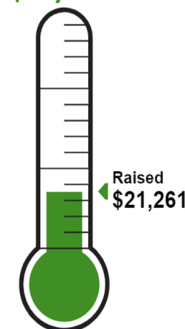
The Pope added how pleased he was that this organ "continues to play and to help people perceive something of the splendor of our faith -- a splendor kindled by the Holy Spirit himself. With it, the organ carries out an evangelizing function, proclaims the Gospel in its own way."

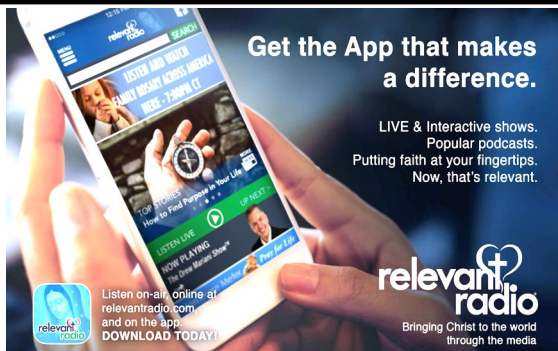

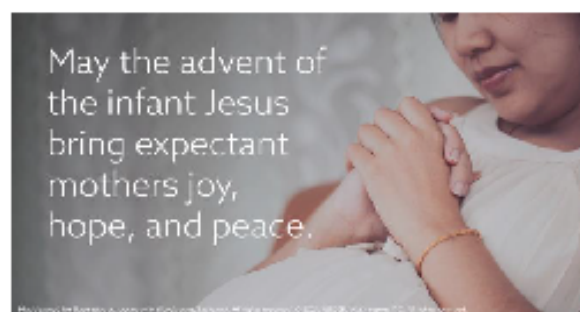

Each year during Advent, we prepare our hearts to celebrate the birth of Christ our Savior at Christmas. As we anticipate this joyful celebration, we recall the journey of the Holy Family from Nazareth to Bethlehem. Far from home, poor, and in great need, Mary and Joseph find refuge in a simple stable. But this humble setting among the livestock soon welcomes the heavenly host of angels and the infant Jesus himself.

Today, women in our own communities are pregnant, poor, perhaps without a home, and in great need. They may feel alone, scared, and overwhelmed, not knowing where to turn. In challenging circumstances, expectant mothers need a refuge of their own. Like the Holy Family, they may be reliant on the kindness of others. Today, may the story of the first Christmas inspire us to reach out to mothers in need. May we proactively seek to offer loving support and encouragement as they prepare to welcome their children. By answering this call, may we help mothers

experience the joy, hope, and peace brought by the infant Jesus. And may we, too, share in and bear witness to the miracle of new life.

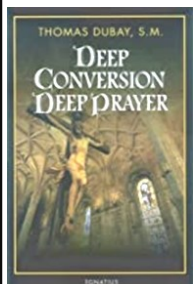

*Las Posadas, celebrated yearly from December 16-24, is a religious festival traditionally held in Mexico and parts of Latin America. Translating to "The Inns" in Spanish, Las Posadas is an important part of the Christmas festivities. Over the nine nights of celebrations, parties are held at different people's homes. Before each gathering, all the guests form a procession to mark Mary and Joseph's search for an inn on the night of Jesus' birth. The march is usually led by an angel as a symbolic act of Mary and Joseph finding shelter in a stable when they were unable to find lodging in Bethlehem. The parties are joyous occasions, including prayers, food, music, fireworks, and piñatas!
