DID YOU KNOW....

where the familiar phrase “bloom where you are planted” comes from? It is from the teachings of St. Francis de Sales (1567-1622) and the full quote is as follows:

“Truly charity has no limit; for the immense love of God has been poured into our hearts by His Spirit dwelling in each one of us, calling us to a life of devotion and inviting us to bloom in the garden where He has planted you and directs you to radiate the beauty and spread the fragrance of His Providence.”

As has been noted before, the ministry of our Parish – indeed, the whole Church – is dependent upon every one of us “blooming. . .and spreading His fragrance.” This is usually called “volunteerism” but actually for believers it is something far more important: it is living our new life, our Baptism – our ‘total immersion’ - into the life of Christ!

One of the unintended consequences of the pandemic lockdowns, was the catastrophic collapse of volunteerism of all kinds, a collapse from which many organizations and service clubs are not recovering. There had been an erosion of volunteerism and community service even before the pandemic, with many organizations and service clubs “greying out” because of the seeming unwillingness of the younger generations to commit to a group and long-term service projects.

Sadly, the issue of “greying out” has become a major concern for the St. Vincent de Paul Society, though not in our own very dynamic Parish Conference of the St.VdeP! Another exception to the erosion of membership in service-oriented clubs is, of course, the Knights of Columbus, which continues to experience phenomenal growth in numbers – internationally!

At the Parish-level, we are seeing a very slow return to the pre-pandemic engagement of our parishioners in the many apostolates and ministries, as well as attendance at Mass. Happily, most of our parishioners understand the necessary connection between faith and service and seek ways to “bloom where they are planted,” not just in Parish activities, but also in community and civic organizations and projects. This sharing of gifts and talents outside the Parish is to “spread the fragrance of His Providence” into all areas of life! To volunteer is actually to “bloom” where God plants you, for your own growth and your maturation in the Faith (“faith active in love”) and to share, as lay-missionaries, in the spreading of the Good News.

Yes, to volunteer in the Parish, one is required to go through a clearance process, because of the Church’s extreme caution that children and vulnerable adults be absolutely safe, especially in the ‘garden’ of the Church. This process is primarily to train all volunteers how to become aware of ‘unsafe’ situations for children and how to report them for rapid response/correction. Our volunteers are actually being trained to become “first responders” in maintaining a safe environment, and thanks to our Compliance Officer, Lupita Teran, this process has been made much, much easier, so this should never be an excuse not to volunteer, not to “bloom”!

To change the metaphor, our Lord has warned us not to ‘bury our talents’ out of fear or selfishness, (Matthew 25: 14-30) because our personal abilities really are a trust, a loan, from God. To use your talents for God’s glory and the spread of His Kingdom, to “bloom where God has planted you,” is not optional in the life of a believer!

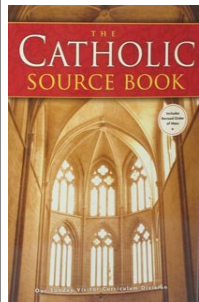

CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "What does the abbreviation 'I H S' stand for?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is the 'Stigmata'?" Stigmata (from the Greek: stigma, meaning the brand on a slave or a criminal) are the marks on a body that correspond to some or all of the wounds of Christ's Passion and crucifixion. No one is required to believe in the divine origin of such a phenomenon, but it is regarded (by Catholics) as a special sign of oneness with Christ's sacrificial suffering. St. Paul refers to bearing the "marks (stigmata) of Christ" on his body (Galatians 6:17) The first well-known 'stigmatic' is St. Francis of Assisi, who suddenly developed bleeding wounds on his hands. Others include St. Catherine of Siena, St. Rita of Cascia, and—in the twentieth century — St. Padre Pio!

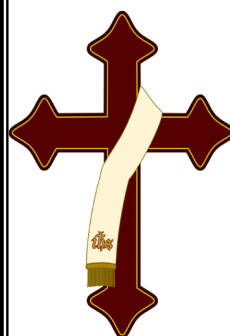

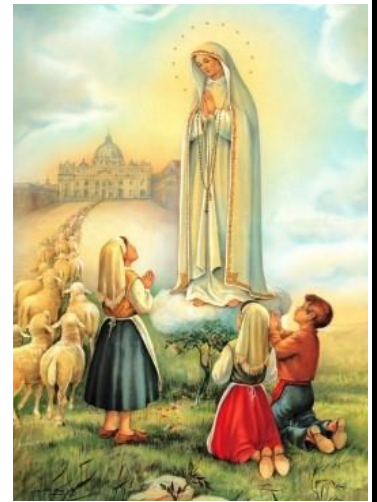

Let's Pray the Rosary, Arizona!

On October 13, 1917, in Fatima, Portugal, over 70,000 people gathered to witness the apparition of Our Lady. What they received was the "Miracle of the Sun".
