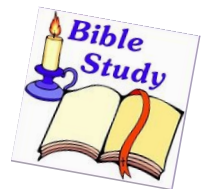

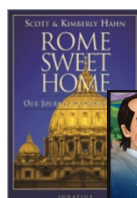

DID YOU KNOW....

that next Saturday we will have an opportunity to say ‘thank you’ and ‘good bye’ to *Fr. Simon Muema*?

We have been greatly blessed to have *Fr. Simon* assigned to us for his first year of Priesthood and to have walked with him as he has graciously and generously ‘opened the gift of his Priesthood’ with us! Certainly Parishes help to shape a Priest’s life and ministry, especially in the first years of Priesthood, but Priests also leave a lasting impression on Parishes, no matter how brief their stay. *Fr. Simon*’s joyful spirit, engaging personality, and obvious love for God’s People have helped us to grow in our faith and our understanding of joyful discipleship. *Pope Francis* told Priests that to be good shepherds, they must ‘smell like the sheep,’ by which he explained, that to be effective in priestly ministry, Priests should be open and accessible to people and their needs and not hold themselves aloof from the daily lived reality of people. *Fr. Simon* has obviously taken the Pope’s words to heart, and makes himself available to people in all kinds of social situations apart from the Mass. We know him to be a good preacher, who shares his life experiences and theological understanding in very engaging ways!

Different groups within the Parish – and also at *Our Lady of the Mountains* – have been having ‘thank you’ celebrations for *Fr. Simon* as he prepares for his new assignment: associate Pastor at *Santa Cruz Parish* in Tucson at the end of this month.

We will have our Parish celebration for *Fr. Simon* next Saturday afternoon from 2:00-4:00 – an ice cream social, hosted by our *Knights of Columbus*!

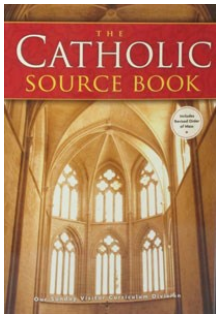

CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "What is a 'presbyter'?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is a 'Doctor of the Church'?" This title is not a medical designation, but identifies a learned teacher (Latin: *docere*: to teach/learn – also the root of the word, 'doctrine': authoritative teaching). A Doctor of the Church is one whose clear teaching, inspired by the Holy Spirit, edifies and builds up the collective wisdom of the whole Church, the 'deposit of Faith'. They are known for their inspired learning, great sanctity, and the Church's Spirit-guided approval – in harmony with Sacred Scripture and the Sacred Tradition. There are now 35 "Doctors of the Church," of whom four are women!

If you would like to be as smart as the "Quiz Master" — pick up a copy of the Catholic Source Book, available in the Parish Office.

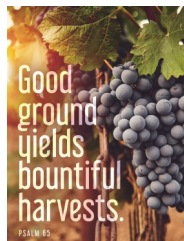

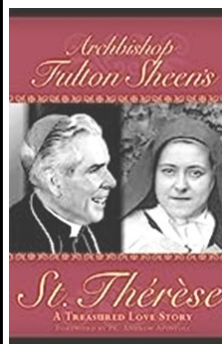

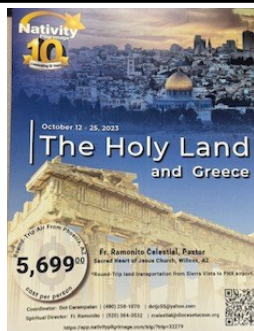

VOCATION VOCABULARY

BROTHER

Men who belong to a religious community and promise to serve the Church in a special way for life (unlike a priest, they do not administer sacraments).

MONK

A member of a men's religious community who lives a life of prayer in a monastery.

SEMINARY

School specializing in classes for students who are studying to become a priest (seminarians).

DEACON

An ordained minister who may preach the Gospel, teach, baptize, lead prayers, witness marriages and conduct wake and funeral services. A married man can become a Deacon if he is over the age of 35.

ORDINATION

Ceremony for men who have fulfilled all the requirements to become a priest; they receive the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

DIOCESAN PRIEST

Priest ordained to serve in one particular diocese, or area of the Church overseen by a bishop or archbishop.

PRIEST

Men who offer leadership and service to the Church and administer the sacraments to God's people.



MOTHER HOUSE

The main home/headquarters for sisters.

SISTER

Woman who takes vows to serve God in a special way, such as teachers, doctors, parish workers.

NUN

Women in religious orders (sisters) living a cloistered (secluded) life of prayer in a monastery.

NOVITIATE

Time of intense spiritual formation in which candidates (often called novices) learn about the community they want to join.

MONASTERY

Home of monks or nuns devoted to prayer.

RELIGIOUS ORDER/ CONGREGATION

National or international group of priests, sisters or brothers who take vows to serve the Lord in a special way, such as teaching or missionary work.

PERPETUAL VOWS

Promise made to commit oneself as a priest, sister or brother for the rest of one's life.

TEMPORARY VOWS

Promise a man or woman makes to spend a period of trial and testing with a religious order.



SACRAMENTAL MARRIAGE

A covenant between a baptized man and a woman that establishes a partnership of the whole life, which is ordered toward the good of the spouses and procreation and education of offspring.
