



## Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord– April 2, 2023

### DID YOU KNOW....

that as we move into the Holiest Week of the year, we have been experiencing an extraordinary response to the Lenten call to conversion in our Parish?

We saw a very large – and growing – response to the Lenten Mission preached by *Fr. Richard Rivera* during the second week of Lent. The Lenten Penance Service on March 20 saw several hundred people receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation over three and half hours, and many shared that they were ‘returning to the Church,’ some after decades of absence!! The special Organ Concert on March 24, “*A Walk Through Holy Week*” brought a large number of visitors, as well as parishioners, to our Sanctuary. On Monday, March 27, the church was again filled for a three-hour Healing Mass, celebrated by *Fr. Marco Basulto*.

Attendance at weekend and weekday Masses is up sharply, Many are participating in the Stations of the Cross each Friday, and many are spending time in Adoration in the *Divine Mercy Chapel*. The Holy Spirit is certainly moving powerfully through the lives of many people this Lent!

This Thursday, we will continue the ‘spiritual pilgrimage’ which we begin on Palm Sunday, with the Mass of the Lord’s Supper, with its focus on the Gift of the Eucharist is one of the most beautiful liturgies of the year and you will not want to miss it! Our Good Friday services are very beautiful at St. Andrew’s, beginning with the “Marian” Stations of the Cross at 12:00 Noon, as we walk with the Virgin Mary on her Son’s Way of Sorrows. From 1:00 – 3:00 PM, *Fr. Rob* will lead us in the *Tre Ore* Service of the “Seven Last Words” with special music, and periods of meditation.

At 3:00 PM – the “Hour of Great Mercy”-- *Deacon John Klein* and the Choir will lead us in the Divine Mercy Chaplet.


At 7:00 PM is the Solemn Liturgy of the Lord’s Passion, with the reading of the Passion according to St. John, the Solemn Intercessions, the Veneration of the Cross, and the Communion of the Pre-Sanctified Elements.

Good Friday is, of course, a Day of Abstinence from meat, and Fasting, for all Catholics over 14 years of age.

There is also a special Collection for the Holy Land, taken throughout the Catholic world on Good Friday. This Collection helps to maintain the churches, shrines, and beleaguered parishes in the Holy Land, under the care of the Franciscan Fathers!

The Sacred *Three Days* of redemption (“*Triduum*” in Latin) are the Holy Spirit’s invitation to experience renewal and revitalizing of your faith: Holy Thursday, with the Liturgy of the Lord’s Supper (7:00PM); Good Friday; and Holy Saturday and the Vigil of the Resurrection (7:00PM).

Please plan on attending all of the beautiful Liturgies of Holy Week and experience the glory and the joy of Easter, by entering into it through the power of the Cross!

**Office of Catholic Schools:** Ensures the spiritual and professional development of Catholic school administrators and teachers. Provides our 17 elementary and 6 high schools with quality application of curricula.

**Office of Pastoral Services:** Provides training and resources, including Catechist Certification Levels I and II; Supports programs that promote respect for the dignity of human life and the Social Mission of the Church; Offers expertise in religious education, family life, liturgy, ministry formation, spirituality, and parish planning; and Provides Spanish language resources and programs of ministry formation and training.

**DIOCESAN MINISTRIES AND NEW PARISH DEVELOPMENT - \$635,000\***

**Office of the Bishop:** Supports the pastoral and administrative ministries of the Bishop, allowing the Bishop to fulfill his pastoral and canonical responsibilities.

**Office of the Moderator of the Curia:** Oversees the efficient use of staff and ensures that personnel of the Curia properly fulfill the offices and responsibilities entrusted to them.

**The Office of Formation:** Provides certification and faith formation of adults, lay ministers, and clergy and provides continuing education and formation for parish ministry leaders.

**Office of Archives:** Preserves and maintains accurate, historical records of the Diocese; and assists parishes, faith communities, and schools in establishing and maintaining current and historical records.

**Office of the Permanent Diaconate:** Provides for invitation, evaluation and formation of new candidates and provides pastoral support and continuing education of permanent deacons.

**Office of the Tribunal:** Cooperates with pastors and with other offices and agencies in fostering pastoral care to persons who are separated, divorced, and those planning a future marriage in the Church.

**Office of Child, Adolescent and Adult Protection:** Thoroughly screen members of the clergy, parish employees, and volunteers who work with children, young people and the vulnerable as part of their Church ministry.

**Office of Property and Insurance Services:** Provides centralized administrative resources and insurance compliance for parish and school facilities.

**Office of Human Resources:** Provides centralized personnel administration for some 2,000 employees in our parishes and schools.

**Fiscal Services:** Provides centralized accounting and bookkeeping services to approximately 38 parishes; will eventually undertake accounting and bookkeeping responsibilities for all parishes in the Diocese.



## REFLECT

Each year, on the Second Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates the Sunday of Divine Mercy, remembering the message Jesus so ardently instructed St. Faustina to spread of His endless mercy and forgiveness to those who seek it. Rooted in Christ's message of Divine Mercy is *trust*: trust that Jesus loves us, desires to heal our souls, and is with us.

This is an especially important message for expectant mothers preparing for the births of their children. They may often be gripped by fear and anxiety, without sources of support. May we prayerfully consider how we are called to help mothers who may be struggling in a particular way. And in our own lives, each of us is invited to come to Jesus just as we are and lay our cares, fears, and anxieties upon Him. The words Christ revealed to St. Faustina, He speaks to us and all who feel afraid: *"Lay your head on my shoulder, rest and regain your strength. I am always with you"* (Diary, no. 848). As we seek to live out the message of Divine Mercy, we pray for the courage for all to proclaim, *"Jesus, I trust in you!"*

## **New Scams Targeting Priests and their Parishioners**

deposited money/western union funds together but the deposit did not go through, so he asked the parish to "cover" the deposit plus additional monies. The caller put on another person who was supposedly from Federal Express and was on the way and needed the money right away. The parish office suspected a scam and told the caller the priest was just walking in the office. The caller then hung up.

The number (131-236-15970) is a Chinese number.

2. The same office received a call the next day claiming to be from the "Eclesiastica" of Los Angeles. He hung up when he was put on speaker phone. The number (805-2579-425) is from Japan. When called, it was apparent that the number was a Call Center and the caller from the previous day could be heard in the background.

Thankfully, the parish office staff did not fall for the scams and reported them to the Diocese of Tucson Chancellor. Please be alert and to never accept any telephone or email solicitations without verifying them personally with you first.

Please be aware that there are at least two new scams that are targeting our parishes.

1. A man claiming to be a deacon called the parish office saying he was down at the Cathedral looking for particular priest. He said he and the priest
