





The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is the difference between 'repentance' and 'contrition'?" Though often confused, 'contrition' means "sorrow for sin" – regret or shame for the evil one has done. It is an awareness of the alienation caused by sin. 'Repentance', on the other hand, is the translation of the Greek word metanoia, meaning a basic change in the direction of one's life. Beyond 'sorrow for sin', repentance describes a change of mind, heart and attitude, that transforms our lives by changing the direction of our lives at God's summons and made possible by His grace. The New Testament uses the word 'repentance' to describe a personal response to the invitation to new life in Christ.




