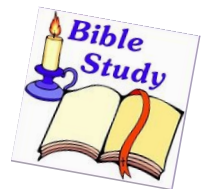

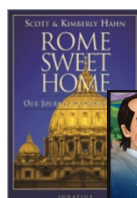

DID YOU KNOW....

that next weekend we will celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi with our wonderful Corpus Christi Procession at 9:00 AM – immediately following the 8:00 AM Mass?

Pope St. John Paul II called participation in the Eucharist the “essential commitment”. In his first encyclical letter to the Faithful, *Redemptor hominis* (‘On the redemption and dignity of the human race’), (1979), the Pope wrote: “*The essential commitment and, above all, the visible grace and source of supernatural strength for the Church as the People of God, is to persevere and constantly advance in Eucharistic life and Eucharistic piety, and to develop spiritually in the climate of the Eucharist.*”

In identifying our “essential commitment” to our Lord and His Church, as fully aware and growing participation in the Eucharist, *Pope St. John Paul II*, was lifting up again, the truth proclaimed by the *Second Vatican Council*, that the ‘Eucharist is the summit and the source of the Church’s life’.

In practice, this means that we are formed and grow, develop and mature in our Christian life by participating in the Mass (and in Eucharistic devotion) as often as we can!

Many have expressed their ‘hunger for the Eucharist’ this past year, during the lockdowns and suspension of “public” Masses, and shared how temporary deprivation of the Eucharist, which we too often take for granted, deepened their awareness of how important (“essential”) the Eucharist truly is in their lives! Catholic churches are never ‘empty’, even if there are no people present! Our churches, because of the Presence of the Lord in the Most Holy Sacrament, are always ‘full’ of God!

An incident comes to mind, of a mentally ill person who was living on the streets, and was found one night, looking into the darkened church, through a space between the locked front doors. The priest asked if he could help her, and she replied, “No, I just wanted to make sure that He is here; and I know that He is, because His porch light is on!” (She was, of course, referring to the Tabernacle light!) In her simplicity, she was pronouncing a great truth: that “He is here!” God is truly “with us” and will be with us, until the consummation of the ages, as He promised, because of the Eucharist!

Our *Bishop Weisenburger* recently wrote: “. . .to choose not to participate personally in Mass when we are capable of doing so, is to deprive ourselves of the immeasurable spiritual graces that can be received only by active participation with others in the Mass!”

And, again, *Pope St. John Paul II*, “*When celebrating the Sacrament of the Body and Blood of the Lord, the full magnitude of the divine mystery must be respected. . . in which Christ is really present and is received, the soul is filled with grace, and the pledge of future glory is given!*”

As *St. John Vianney*, the ‘Cure d’Ars, simply put it: “We go to heaven, one Communion at a time!”

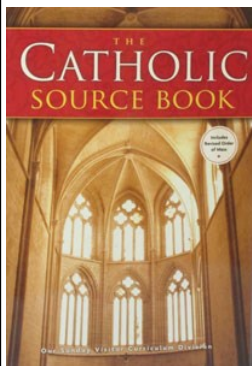

According to the *Gospel of John*, our Lord makes five promises regarding the Advocate - the Holy Spirit: 1) that He is the Spirit of Truth and will be with us forever (*John 14:16-17*); 2) that the Holy Spirit will teach us everything we need to know about salvation and will remind us of all that JESUS has taught us (*John 14:26*); 3) that the Advocate will bear witness to the Truth of God, revealed fully in JESUS (*John 15:26*); 4) that the Holy Spirit comes to us, sent by the Son, after the Son leaves (*John 16:7b*); and, 5) that when He comes, He will guide us into all truth and will declare to us the things that are to come. (*John 16:13*)

SOUL FOOD:

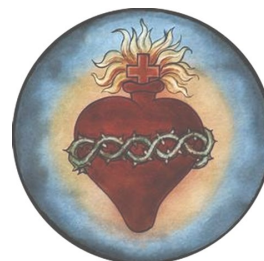

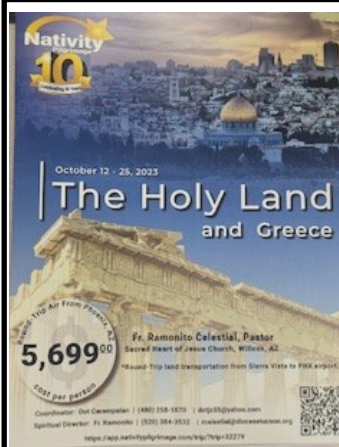

At each GriefShare session you will find encouragement and help in grieving the death of your loved one. No matter the cause of your loved one's death, this is an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling. You will learn how to recognize the symptoms of being stuck in grief and how to cope with the normal emotions that come when grieving a death. You will learn valuable information on facing life situations, and you'll gain renewed hope for the future. These sessions are open to anyone regardless of whether your experience is recent or not so recent. The group is led by individuals who have personally experienced grief due to a loved one's death. Each leader is trained in facilitating a GriefShare support group.

Our GriefShare group will meet every Wednesday, starting May 24th, 2023,
5 p.m.to 7:00 p.m. in Madonna Hall, room #3.

We hope you will consider joining us. Please remember your loss is shared by others in this church and what you are experiencing is sometimes easier to bear knowing others are listening and do care. May God's love continue to comfort and strengthen you.
