Blessed Anne of St. Bartholomew (1549-1626)



Ana Garcia was born in Almendral, Castille, Spain, in 1549. In 1570 she joined the Discalced Carmelite nuns of the newly-formed St. Joseph's convent in Avila, under the reform initiated by St. Teresa, as the reform's first lay sister. Anne was very dear to St. Teresa, who admitted her to formation in 1572. She soon be-Teresa's assistant, travel companion and nurse on her journeys to monasteries and convents; found new Teresa ordered her to write, which she learned to do almost miraculously. After St. Teresa died in 1582, Anne was a member of the communities of Avila, Madrid and Ocana in Spain and, in 1604, joined Blessed Anne of Jesus in initiating the reform in France. She then went to Belgium and founded a monastery in Anvers, where she spent the last 14 years of her life and where her body is preserved. She was beatified in 1917. 




