

Once a month, on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday morning of the month – 19 August – you are invited to





CATHOLIC The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is an 'apostolic constitution'?" This refers to a papal document that is solemn in form and binding in content, and ordinarily deals with matters of faith, doctrine, or discipline that are important for the universal Church or for a particular portion of the Church. For example, an 'apostolic constitution' may deal with the liturgical practices of a particular national church, but based on principles applicable to the whole Church. An 'apostolic constitution' allows the Pope to address particular questions without invoking a synod or a Council.




