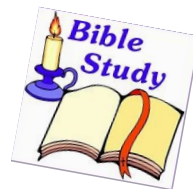

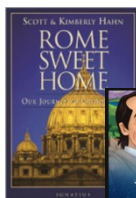

DID YOU KNOW...

that St. Andrew's is one of the 'pilot Parishes' for an exciting new initiative for men's spirituality?

The *Knights of Columbus* have crafted a dynamic new Nation-wide program for gathering men to pray together, learn about and discuss topics relevant to living a purpose-driven Catholic life, and to share fellowship (friendship-building in Christ).

This initiative called "COR" (from the Latin word for heart, as in 'core beliefs, core integrity, core commitments) is being developed at the Parish level, and St. Andrew's has been chosen as one of the Parishes to inaugurate this initiative and to develop it at the Parish level. It is open to all men in the Parish!

You do not have to be a member of the *Knights of Columbus* in order to take advantage of this 'faith-lift'! All are welcome to participate.

Once a month, on the 3rd Saturday morning of the month – 19 August – you are invited to share in the 9:00 AM Mass, followed by a brief (20-minute) period of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, moving into Kino Hall for coffee and a light breakfast, and listening to a brief, engaging video on various timely topics of Catholic spirituality for men, followed by a brief discussion around the tables, and a closing.

The whole thing, including Mass, is about 2 hours! Two hours of 'spiritual exercise' a month, with other men who share your calling and are intentional in their desire for a deeper discipleship!

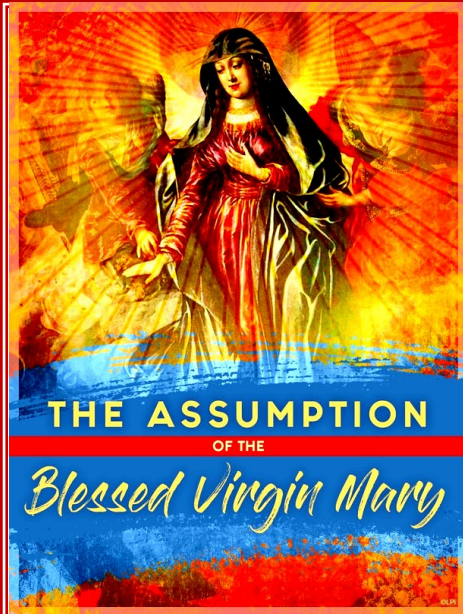

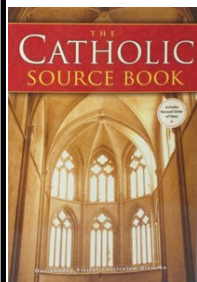

The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is an 'apostolic constitution'?" This refers to a papal document that is solemn in form and binding in content, and ordinarily deals with matters of faith, doctrine, or discipline that are important for the universal Church or for a particular portion of the Church. For example, an 'apostolic constitution' may deal with the liturgical practices of a particular national church, but based on principles applicable to the whole Church. An 'apostolic constitution' allows the Pope to address particular questions without invoking a synod or a Council.

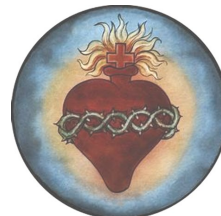
