## DID YOU KNOW....

that one of the most exciting developments in the spiritual life of our Parish in the past few years is the extraordinary growth in Eucharistic Adoration!

As part of the National Eucharistic Renewal taking place these three years – with the Eucharistic Congress coming up 17-24 July in Indianapolis – we have seen a tremendous growth in Eucharistic devotion, Adoration, Processions, and awareness!

Adoration on First Fridays has been a long-standing practice of our Parish, but so many groups, ministries and individuals are choosing to spend time in quiet adoration before Christ in the Blessed Sacrament! Among the groups who have regularly scheduled times of Adoration each week are: 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade Religious Ed (Sunday), Spanish Rosary Prayer Group (Monday), Confirmation Classes (Monday), Men's Prayer Group (Tuesday), Middle School Religious Ed Classes (Tuesday), Charismatic Prayer Group (Tuesday), Our Lady of Perpetual Help Novena (Wednesday), *Noche de Alabanza* Prayer Group (Wednesday), *Hijos de Maria* (Children) (Wednesday), First Communion Classes (Wednesday and Thursday), Family Holy Hour (Friday), Life Teen (Friday), Men's COR Group (Saturday), Secular Carmelite Order (Saturday), Seven Sisters Apostolate. Some of these groups meet daily, some weekly, and some monthly – and no matter what the group, any one is welcome to join them for Adoration – no group in our Parish is “closed” to other Parishioners but welcomes you to join them in this most beautiful of prayers!

Whether alone or worshipping with a group of your fellow Parishioners, the effects are powerful and striking! It has been widely observed that in parishes where Eucharistic Adoration is regular and not just occasional, marriage is strengthened, people report greater peace in their personal and family lives, Vocations increase, and people come to Confession more regularly. This should not be a surprise to anyone, because our Lord has said:


*“If I be lifted up, I will draw all men and women to Myself!”* (John 12:32) Spending even a few minutes with the Lord in the Blessed Sacrament can and will transform your day!

The verse on the altar cloth in the *Divine Mercy Chapel* reads: *“Hic Amor Aeternus Habitat”*: “Here Love Eternally Dwells”. Those who spend quiet time in His Presence find this to be true! Come, and let God love you!

(The ‘code’ for the door of the *Divine Mercy Chapel* is 1-9-5-8 (the year that the Parish was founded!) and the *Chapel* is lighted 24/7.

We are doing SUPER on our response to the *Annual Catholic Appeal* this year and it appears that we will reach our Parish Goal in time for Easter! It is so important that every Parishioner and every Family participate in this great Lenten opportunity to give Alms/Mercy to our fellow Catholics in the Diocese of Tucson – and to touch countless lives through our Diocesan-wide ministries! ## CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: “Why are the statues and crucifix veiled during the last two weeks of Lent?”



The Answer to Last Week's Question: “What is ‘Mothering Sunday’?” This is one of the ‘aliases’ of *Laetare* (*Rejoice*) Sunday – the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent! There was an ancient custom of visiting one's ‘mother church’ – (where you had been baptized: ‘born again’) – on

*Laetare Sunday*! In the natural evolution of this pilgrimage to your ‘mother parish’, people would spend time with mother and families. Naturally, roses were the traditional flowers for the day, because rose was the color of the vestments at Mass on *Laetare Sunday*. After Mass, roses were taken to mothers, along with special cakes and gifts. Long before Anna Jarvis held her service to honor all mothers or Woodrow Wilson proclaimed the second Sunday of May to be ‘Mothers’ Day’ in 1914, Catholic folks were honoring mothers, spiritual and natural, and this mid-Lent Sunday had become a day of family reunions and festivity!

### Mission for the Week


Help your parents wash dishes. As you take dirty dishes and wash them clean, talk about how Jesus washed our sins away on the cross.

**GriefShare** is a nationwide biblical support group that is focused on helping people who are dealing with a loved one's death. Each DVD session features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories, followed by small group discussion about the topics presented (with workbook support). The workbook also provides a brief daily Bible study.

At each **GriefShare** session you will find encouragement and help in grieving the death of your loved one. No matter the cause of your loved one's death, this is an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling. You will learn how to recognize the symptoms of being stuck in grief and how to cope with the normal emotions that come when grieving a death. You will learn valuable information on facing life situations, and you'll gain renewed hope for the future. These sessions are open to anyone regardless of whether your experience is recent or not so recent. The group is led by individuals who have personally experienced grief due to a loved one's death.

Each leader is trained in facilitating a **GriefShare** support group. Our next **GriefShare** group meets [every Wednesday starting March 13th, 2024, time 5:00pm to 7:00pm, Madonna Hall room #3]. We hope you will consider joining us.

Please remember your loss is shared by others in this church and what you are experiencing is sometimes easier to bear knowing others are listening and do care.
