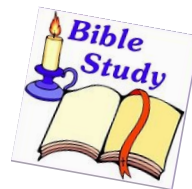

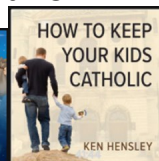

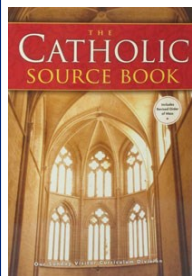

CATHOLIC QUIZ: *This week's Question: "Who is the Patron Saint of the Incarcerated?"*



The answer to last week's Question: "Are there any 'official' translations of the Mass in Native American languages?" In 1986 the Vatican approved a translation of most parts of the Mass into Navajo, the first Native American language to be so approved. (Navajo had been given 'liturgical language' status in 1983, which allowed the translation to proceed.) Following Navajo, Choctaw became a 'liturgical language' in 1984, with a translation into that language in 1987. Other languages gained 'liturgical language' status in the following years! The "Creed", "Our Father", "Hail Mary", and "Glory Be" had all been translated into Native American languages within a short time after first contact with missionaries. Some of these translations carry a beautiful Native perspective, such as the early 18th century Algonquin translation of the phrase, 'lead us not into temptation': *"do not let our hearts become hardened"*!

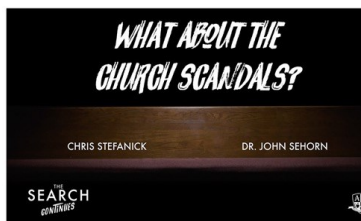
