

DID YOU KNOW....

that there is an easy "fix" - IF you want a change in what you see on television or on your Ipad? Turn it OFF!

The trouble is, people do not turn it off – we will watch almost anything. The 'claimed' purpose of TV may be for information and entertainment, but we use it for something to do, to babysit our children, sometimes as a substitute for real life with real people, and as a way of visualizing fantasies that we would never dare to act out in person. *Pope Francis* observed: "Virtual reality is <u>not</u> reality and can, if fact, diminish our ability to engage in reality."

Routine television programming is often boring, and, if you think about it, often degrading and dehumanizing – soap operas, greed-inducing game shows, horrific violence, unnatural relationships, unreal 'sit-coms', very un-real 'reality shows' – but we watch it!

If greed, stupidity, third-rate romantic triangles, and bigotry are "entertainment", then what about rape, murder, deceit, infidelity, torture, and just plain stealing? Television appeals to the sense of sin – placing before us in dazzling packaging that which should be abhorred and avoided. Much of what is presented as entertainment is, in reality, a near occasion of sin.

Theater-goers during the Roman Empire became so jaded that acting was often replaced by real people who were really raped, crucified, tortured, murdered, and killed by wild animals, right on stage, before large audiences which over time developed a 'taste' for brutality, blood, and violence. They became hardened of heart and indifferent to the suffering inflicted on others in the name of entertainment.

Something similar may be happening to us. We are mistaken if we think that all TV is idle fantasy and harmless entertainment. It is often a mirror of our very worst attitudes and attractions. Morality, or the lack of it, on many if not most TV shows is eroding our sensibilities and sensitivity and makes us the prey of very evil manipulation and highly addictive porn in many forms. Television programming is called 'programming' because viewers are being 'programmed' and our souls are being numbed and dumbed, so that we will purchase the items/ products advertised and seek a false sense of security – in things. A Christian is not only required to care for his or her soul by refusing to sin, but also by avoiding "near occasions of sin" which would include a great deal of what is on TV today. Place a picture of our Lord or our Blessed Mother on top of your television set or as your screen saver and, before you watch anything, ask yourself if this is something that you would like to watch with them?

Check out our Parish Library for some quality reading and viewing this summer! Think about it.



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is a 'pastor'?" A 'pastor' (from the Latin word for 'shepherd') is the ordained minister charged with responsibility for the sacramental, doctrinal, and related spiritual services of people committed to his care. For example, the pope is the 'pastor' for the whole Church, a bishop for those in his diocese, and a priest for his parishioners. This is the basis of Pope Francis' well-known challenge to the clergy, that "a shepherd should smell like the sheep." Meaning, of course, that those charged with pastoral care should share as fully in the lives of the people they serve as possible, not holding themselves apart because of some imagined superiority. Catholics see this pastoral responsibility as flowing from the words spoken to Simon Peter by our Lord – John 21:15-17. St. Augustine explained this role to his parishioners with these words: "With you I am a Christian. For you I am a bishop!"
