DID YOU KNOW....

That for Catholics, Christmas is not just a day, but a whole Season? The secular culture around us begins “celebrating the Holidays” around the middle of October – on the shelves of most stores, you can find Halloween items and candy, adjacent to Christmas cards and gifts – and this all abruptly stops, along with the Christmas music on the 26th!

In our secular culture the “Holidays” are not “Holy Days” but rather a “Great Shopping Season” - with “post-holiday sales” – which is the “Holidays” for many people, especially those living in the First (Developed) World.

For Catholics – and remember that most Catholics live in the undeveloped Third World – ours is very much a Third World Church - Christmas has a much deeper, richer meaning.

And so, the Season of Christmas – begins with the Vigil Mass of Christmas Eve and concludes with the Feasts of Epiphany/Baptism of the Lord, and is second only in significance to the Easter Season. This is the “*Twelve Days of Christmas*” that we hear sung about, but which for the most part is not understood nor appreciated.

The Feast Days include: Christmas (December 25th), Holy Family (celebrated this year on Sunday, 31 December), Mary, Mother of God (January 1st), Epiphany (Usually, the Sunday after January 1st and this year, celebrated on 7 January), and Baptism of our Lord (This year celebrated on Monday, 8 January).

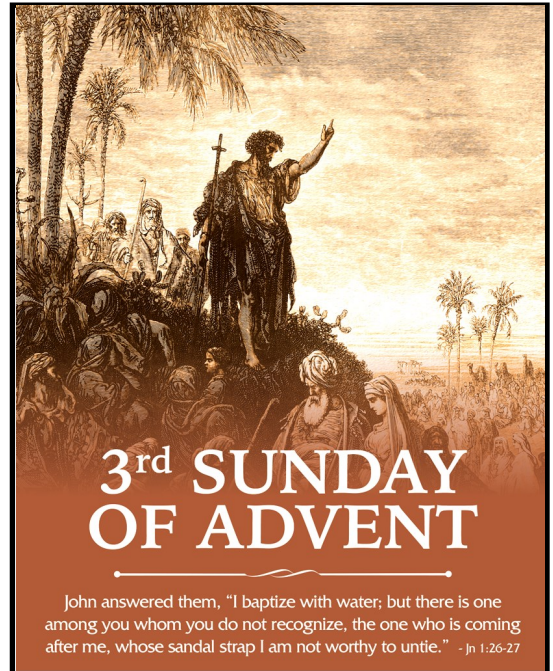
Keeping the Church’s Seasons is an important exercise in learning “holy time” – called, in Greek, *Kairos*: a ‘season’ of quality time, an essence of meaning, significance, and spiritual opportunities! Be aware that our Catholic understanding of seasons is more and more “counter cultural” in a society which has largely lost its sense of holy times and seasons, as well as the necessity of anticipation and delayed gratification. Hence, our society’s interpretation of the ‘the Holidays’ as a period of frantic shopping and ersatz “holiday cheer” which begins in the middle of October and terminates on December 26th – with little or no marking of the “reason for the season”.

The personal challenge for us, as Catholics, in this secular environment, is to be willing to be “counter cultural” and to live in the *Kairos* of God’s time – a ‘vertical’ experience of life!

Keep the Season of Christmas in your heart and in your home! Do not be a ‘convert’ to the secularism surrounding us! Celebrate the true meaning of Christmas by ‘savoring it’ and not simply surviving the “Holidays”!

Pope St. Paul VI (1897-1978) once said, “*When it’s easy to be a Catholic, it’s hard to be a good Catholic. When it’s hard to be a Catholic, it’s easier to be a good Catholic!*” The Pope certainly understood the pressures of modern living and the temptations of secularism!

Be a good Catholic – keep the Season of Christmas in your heart and in your home!

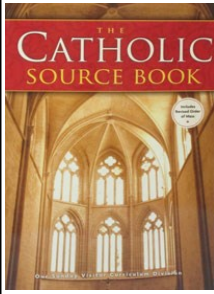

CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "When and at what time was Christ born?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is 'Gaudete Sunday'?" Advent is the expectation of the Coming of Christ and is penitential in tone (thus: violet vestments and no "Gloria" in the Masses of Advent). The first two weeks focus on the Final Coming of our Lord as Judge and Restorer of the creation. The final eight days anticipate the celebration of His coming in history (Christmas). The Third Sunday of Advent 'relieved' the penitential, more somber, tone of the Season, and reminds the Faithful to *"Rejoice in the Lord always! And again, I say, rejoice!"* (Rejoice: *Gaudete!* (Latin)) from the opening Antiphon of today's Mass. The liturgical color is Rose, as also is used mid-Lent on *Laetare Sunday!*

The term of our current Parish Board Secretary, Ann Dickson, will expire on January 19, 2024. Father Greg has nominated Ann for another three-year term. In addition to Father Greg's nomination, registered members of the parish may submit names for this position by completing the required forms and obtaining a total of ten signatures of registered parishioners. Permission of the proposed nominee should be obtained prior to submitting a nomination. Nomination forms are available in the parish office, along with information on eligibility requirements. The deadline for receipt of additional nominations is Friday, December 29.

The Secretary is responsible for Parish corporate record keeping, other than financial records. Examples are: corporate minutes, documents, notices and correspondence. The Secretary also coordinates with the Diocesan Office of Corporate Matters on the maintenance of official parish corporate records, ensuring that parish records are kept in an orderly fashion. The Secretary will always be a lay member of the Board of Directors.

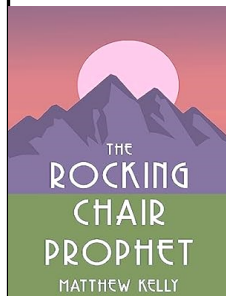
