A "Novena of Grace" was traditionally prayed in March (introduced to this area by our own *Padre Eusebio Kino*!) and a "Christmas Novena" begins 16 December and honors the mystery of Christmas. Today the recommended (and only Scriptural) novena is the one preceding Pentecost!


FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATIONS
