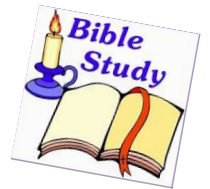

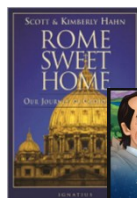

I wish all Catholics could experience this

"community of saints"—not necessarily already perfected, but certainly saintly in direction and by grace-- in this way. The youngest and one of the newest cardinals, Georgio Marengo from Mongolia (a friend from the Central Asian Bishops' Conference) speaks of "whispering the Gospel" to all around us and always. I find this a captivating image for all Christians, no matter who or where they are.

I am equally edified by the continued faithfulness of the Church in Sierra Vista. I sure wish I could visit; nevertheless, please pass on my prayers and best wishes."

We are so grateful for the wonderful experience of the Universal Church and our shared global mission, which becomes personalized for us in such truly inspiring Missionaries, like *Fr. Anthony*, *Fr. Silas (Nepal)*, *Joan Martin* and *Fr. William (Haiti)*, *Fr. Abraham (Ecuador)*, and our own 'resident Missionaries' *Fr. Samuel* and *Fr. Simon!*

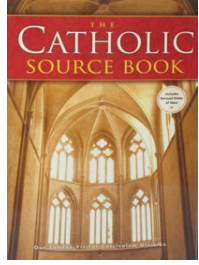

CATHOLIC QUIZ: This Week's Question: "What is the 'Mass of the Resurrection'?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is the 'Dies Irae' recited in Masses for the Dead?" The "Day of Wrath" is a medieval hymn about Judgment Day; it was used as the sequence hymn at funerals and for All Souls' Day; based upon *Joel 2:31*. This ancient hymn was included in funeral Mass and Masses offered for the Souls in Purgatory, to plead the sinner's cause before the Judgment Seat of God. Remembering that the "Four Last Things" are: death, judgment, Heaven or Hell! The month of November is a special time to remember the "Holy Souls" and the '*Dies Irae*' is an appropriate reflection/prayer for our consideration!

As St. Pio of Pietrelcina once said, "We must empty Purgatory with our prayers." Yes, he was convinced that it can be done... and we should be, too.

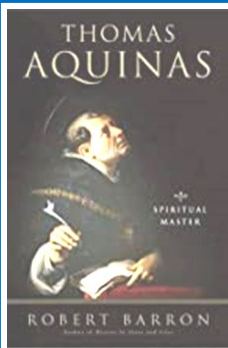
NOTICE of Nomination for position of TREASURER of the Corporate Board of Directors of Saint Andrew the Apostle.

If other nominations are received, the Election will be held on Sunday the 4th of December.

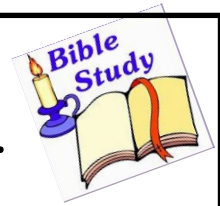

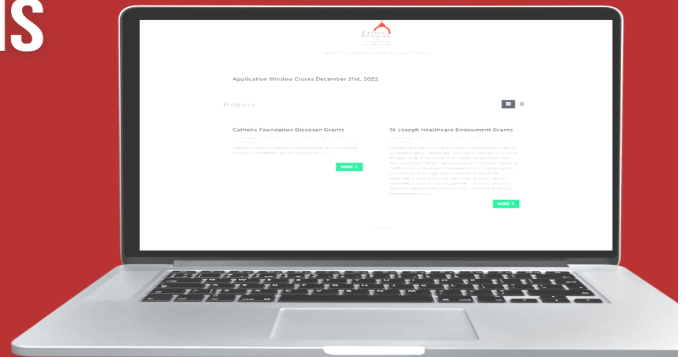


"The Mission of the Catholic Church is Evangelization!"
