#### DID YOU KNOW....

that this weekend, we celebrate the First Communion of 39 of our children?

We are so grateful to *Sister Joellen*, and her wonderful 'formation team' who have been preparing our First Communicants for this very special day. Those who have been part of this team are: *Linda Wilker, Regina Kelly, Juana Taite, Aiden Kelly*!

What would it be like if we were deprived of food and drink for months at a time? We would, of course, weaken and die. For many Catholics this is exactly what it felt like to be deprived of participation in the Mass during the lockdowns caused by the corona virus pandemic! We were hungry and thirsty to receive the Body and Blood of Christ but had to 'make do' with on-line liturgies and 'spiritual communions'!

We yearned to be physically present to our Lord JESUS, who is Himself physically present to us in the Most Holy Sacrament. Our physical absence highlighted all the more our hunger and thirst for the Eucharist, the Real Presence of Christ.

As our Bishop shared at the time, perhaps this gave us a uniquely graced opportunity to be in solidarity with the many Catholics who are deprived of the Mass and the opportunity to receive Christ in the Eucharist, because of persecution!

Our deprivation of the Eucharist because of the pandemic was a test of faith for many. Although some have not returned to the Mass and have fallen into the too easy practice of 'watching Mass' online, for many, many others, physical absence from Mass for a time only intensified the desire for the Real Presence! (As *Pope Francis* cautioned during the period of lockdown and participation in the Mass via livestreaming, "Virtual reality is not Reality.")

If there is just one thing which defines us as "practicing Catholics", it is participation in the Mass, which the Church rightly calls the "summit and the source of the Church's life!

St. Alphonsus Liguouri asked the question, "How can a person receive Communion so often, and with so little effect?" His answer was two-fold: 'A lack of preparation before and a lack of follow-through.' If we fail in either, the result is a very half-hearted, even 'routine' reception of the greatest gift of our God's love!

Consider the preparation of our young ones for their First Holy Communion! How can we be more prepared for the Gift? Just as every Baptism gives us the opportunity to renew – in some way – our own Baptism, so the occasion of the First Communion presents us an opportunity to be renewed in our love for our Lord in the Most Holy Sacrament – the Gift!

Thank you all, again, for your most generous response to our "Second Mile" effort on behalf of our *Annual Catholic Appeal*! We are now at 119% of our Parish Goal – truly a "Second Mile" effort!







## HAND CARVED in BETHLEHEM—After ALL the MASSES the Weekend of (May 7 & 8).

PLEASE STOP BY THE TABLES OF RELIGIOUS WARES (Nativity set, rosaries, statues, crucifixes, charms, etc.)

Ayman Khair is representing about 180 Christian families from Bethlehem. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East and the Pandemic, tourism has been stopped completely from March 2, 2020, till February 2022. It is very important to support them at this critical time since they have no income and there is no government to take care of them and help them. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United State to purchase their articles.

These hand carved religious articles are beyond description. Carved from wood of the sacred Olive tree, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income and are able to stay living and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support.
