

DID YOU KNOW....

that work is underway to bring our sound system in the church up to top performance?


The Parish/Finance Council, working with the Buildings and Grounds Committee, contracted with our parishioner, Gonzalo Garcia, to submit a bid for the upgrading of the sound system in the church. Gonzalo installed our security camera system and has done other work on our Parish campus. As part of the preparation for the work, two sound engineering firms, Sweetwater and Area 51 Audio & Video Engineering came and did on-site testing. In the course of their testing, they determined that the present ceiling speakers are located too high above the floor, creating a kind of 'delay' in the sound, as well as discovering that two of the speakers are not operational, creating "dead zones" in the church. They recommended the placement of speakers along the walls, just above the niches where the statues of the saints are located. These top-of-the-line speakers are mounted on swivels and the sound can be engineered to 'overlap', this helps make sure everyone hears the audio clearly, no matter where they are in the church, directing and spreading the sound so that everyone enjoys the experience. As the first step in the project the 16-year old amplifiers were all replaced and wired correctly, and repair work completed on the control panel in the sound booth (in the balcony). The difference in the level of sound was immediately noticeable – as many of you have pointed out!

Gonzalo also found problems with the sound system wiring in the Choir area, and that wiring is in the process of being replaced.

The Parish/Council wanted to determine if there was enough of an improvement in the sound that new speakers would not be necessary. If new speakers are not purchased, then the ceiling speakers which are not currently operational will have to be rewired. On Friday, members of the Buildings and Grounds Committee, and members of the Parish/Finance Council met with *Gonzalo* to discuss these questions and to determine the next steps in bringing our sound system up to peak performance.

Part of the project will include the training of all of our volunteer sound technicians, as well as the Lectors (and clergy), on best practices to make the sound system work most efficiently.

We appreciate your patience as we work together to provide the very best sound system that we can!
