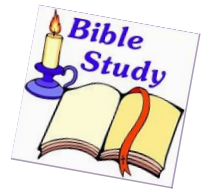

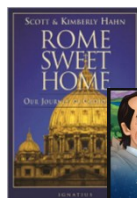

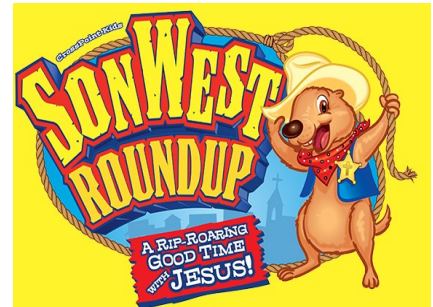
We have also received the good news that we will be able to resume (after two and a half years!) our Ministry to the Incarcerated at the County Jail in Bisbee, beginning in June!

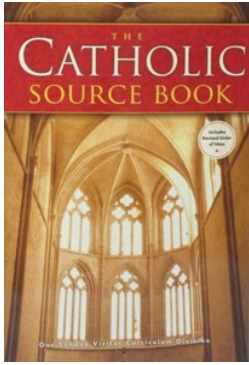

**CATHOLIC QUIZ:** This week's Question: "What is the origin of a 'Novena'?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is the 'College of Cardinals'?" Also called the "Sacred College," the College of Cardinals has existed since the early Church, although its exact origins are unclear. By the 11<sup>th</sup> Century, it had become a group with great influence, being the Pope's principal advisors on both governance and doctrine. It included bishops, priests, and some deacons of Rome and surrounding dioceses. In the time of Pope Nicholas II (1059), cardinals became the papal "electors". Typically, Cardinals are selected by the Pope from among archbishops of principle or historical sees, or, exceptionally, another bishop, whom the Pope wants as an advisor. Today the College still functions in an advisory capacity to the Pope, and, frequently to head various 'departments' of the Church. The "Sacred College" is limited to no more than 120 cardinals who are under the age of eighty, and thus eligible to elect a Pope. The cardinals are from around the world and truly give a "Catholic" – 'Universal' – dimension to the Church's Petrine Ministry!

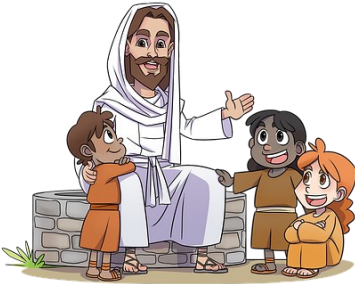

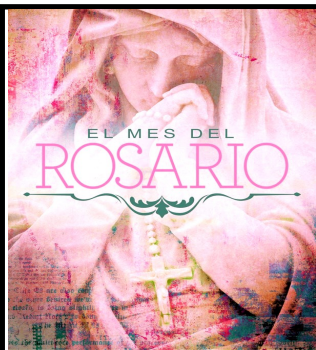

GriefShare is a nationwide biblical support group that is focused on helping people who are dealing with a loved one's death. Each DVD session features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories, followed by small group discussion about the topics presented (with workbook support).

At each GriefShare session you will find encouragement and help in grieving the death of your loved one. No matter the cause of your loved one's death, this is an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling. You will learn how to recognize the symptoms of being stuck in grief and how to cope with the normal emotions that come when grieving a death. You will learn valuable information on facing life situations, and you'll gain renewed hope for the future. These sessions are open to anyone regardless of whether your experience is recent or not so recent. The group is led by individuals who have personally experienced grief due to a loved one's death. Each leader is trained in facilitating a GriefShare support group.

Our GriefShare group will meet every Wednesday, starting May 24th, 2023, 5 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in Madonna Hall, room #3.

We hope you will consider joining us. Please remember your loss is shared by others in this church and what you are experiencing is sometimes easier to bear knowing others are listening and do care. May God's love continue to comfort and strengthen you.

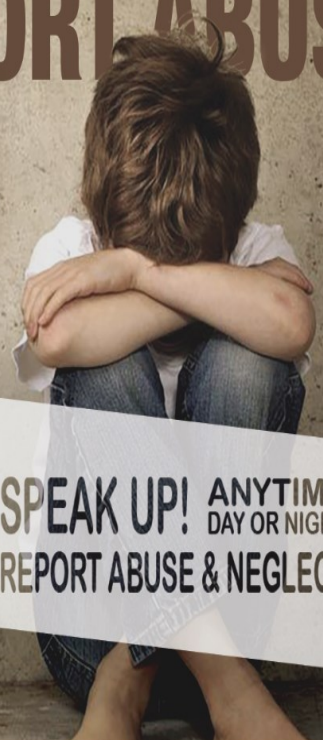
