

that our Seminarian *Carlos Nagore*, has arrived at *St. Andrew's*!

We are very blessed to have our Diocese's only Seminarian assigned to us for His internship year and we welcome this very energetic and outgoing young man, as we walk with him on his journey to the Priesthood! *Carlos* is a native of Tucson (*Our Lady of Fatima Parish*) and was born on 2 July 1998. His parents are *Luis* and *Patricia*, and he has a brother, *Vincent*, and a sister, *Sophia*.

Carlos is in his second year of Theology at St. John's Seminary in Camarillo, California and is on track for his Ordination to the Priesthood in 2026! He will be in residence in the Rectory with *Fr. Samuel* and *Fr. Greg*, and he will be involved in the full range of Parish activities this year! Please invite him to meet your family and experience your wonderful hospitality during his time with us!

Carlos is the only Seminarian currently studying for our Diocese, and this is a matter of great concern for all of us! Our Diocese has instituted a special program to increase Vocations to the Priesthood and Consecrated Religious Life. Our *Deacon Bill* is heading up our own Parish Vocations Committee, and if you would be interested in serving on that Committee, please contact *Deacon Bill*!

We have a wonderful group, called the 'Seekers', of young men who have expressed interest in the Priesthood, and under the guidance of *Father Michael Martinez*, Pastor of *Our Lady of the Mountains*, and, again, our *Deacon Bill*, this group of 12-15 young men from our two Parishes have been meeting every couple of months for the past year for a time of Prayer, Dinner, and Discussion. They have also met with some of the Priests in our area who have shared their own Vocation stories with the group and answered questions.

The next meeting of the 'Seekers' will be this Thursday, 31 August, here at *St. Andrew's*, beginning with Evening Prayer in the *Divine Mercy Chapel* at 6:00PM and dinner (provided by the *Knights of Columbus*) following in the Rectory! AND our *Bishop Weisenburger* will be joining the 'Seekers' this Thursday!

One of the ways that we can encourage Vocations is something that YOU yourself can do!

If you know of a young man who you think might be interested in finding out more about God's Call to ministry, OR, if you have noticed a young man who exhibits a love for God and the Church, YOU can invited them to join the 'Seekers' this Thursday evening for a "look-see" and join with other young men discerning God's Will for their lives! OR, let *Deacon Bill* or one of our Priests know, so that we can invite them!



CATHOLIC QUIZ: *This week's Question: "What about JESUS' 'brothers and sisters' mentioned in the Bible?"*



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What about the "Friday Fast" – is there still such a thing?" From the 1st century, the day of the crucifixion has been traditionally observed as a day of fasting and abstinence from flesh meat to honor Christ who was sacrificed for us on a Friday. (Mark 2:20 *"But the day will come when the Bridegroom will be taken away from them, and then they will fast."*) Until 1966, the regulations for day of fasting prescribed only one full daily meal, plus breakfast and a light meal. In 1966, *Pope Paul VI* issued new instructions on fasting in which: 1) The meaning of fasting was emphasized. 2) The obligation was restated. 3) The extent of the obligation was changed (ages). 4) The universal fast and abstinence days, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, were confirmed. 5) Some other act of penance should be followed on all Fridays if abstinence from meat is not practiced.



"Sharing the Land of Canaan"


