## DID YOU KNOW....

that we have a wonderful Concert taking place this Sunday at Saint Andrew's?

Our Organ Committee has scheduled concerts throughout the year, most of which feature the 1949 Moller pipe organ, and bring artists from around the area to perform in our sanctuary.

This Sunday we will be treated to a very special Concert at 2:00 PM, featuring exquisite sacred music, including original compositions and arrangements by our Diocesan Master Musician, *Carlos Zapien* and the *St. Augustine Cathedral Schola* from Tucson!

Three years ago, Mr. Zapien was commissioned by the *Kino Heritage Society* of the Diocese to compose three pieces of music – 'O Lux Beata', 'Magnificat', and 'Litany of Loreto' -- to be featured in *Vespers* in honor of *Padre Eusebio Francisco Kino*, "the Apostle of Arizona", who died on 15 March 1711.

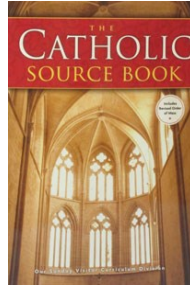
Through a special grant by the Chouinard Family Trust in memory of Patricia Chouinard, these pieces were performed and videoed in historic San Xavier del Bac Mission and are accessible on YouTube!

These very beautiful, ethereal pieces will be featured in Sunday's program, along with other compositions and unique arrangements of traditional pieces of sacred music!

*Carlos Zapien* studied at the *Conservatorio de Las Rosas* in *Morelia, Mexico* and earned advanced degrees from the *University of Oregon* and *Staatliche Hochschule fur Musik* in *Stuttgart, Germany*. A concert and recording artist, as well as a composer, his works have been performed in the United States, Canada, Austria, Germany, Argentina, Australia, France, Italy, and Mexico! The *St. Augustine Cathedral Schola* is an exceptional group of singers who perform concerts and provide special music for liturgical celebrations in the Cathedral, under the direction of Mr. Zapien.

As we begin the days of *Passiontide* leading up to Holy Week, this Concert can be a wonderful spiritual experience leading to a deeper appreciation of this sacred season! This is a gift not to be missed!

**CATHOLIC QUIZ:** This week's Question: "Why is Holy Thursday called 'Maundy Thursday'?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "Why are the statues and crucifix veiled the last two weeks of Lent?" The custom of veiling the crucifix and the statues from two Sundays before Easter until Good Friday, comes from the Gospel – which in the old days was always from JOHN 8:59: "They picked up stones to throw at Him, but He hid himself and went out of the Temple." The 'Lenten Veil' also expresses the deep sorrow of the Church at the approach of the Savior's Passion and Death. (While not required, the *Roman Missal* allows for this ancient practice, which we observe in our Parish.)

## ***Praying Through Singing***

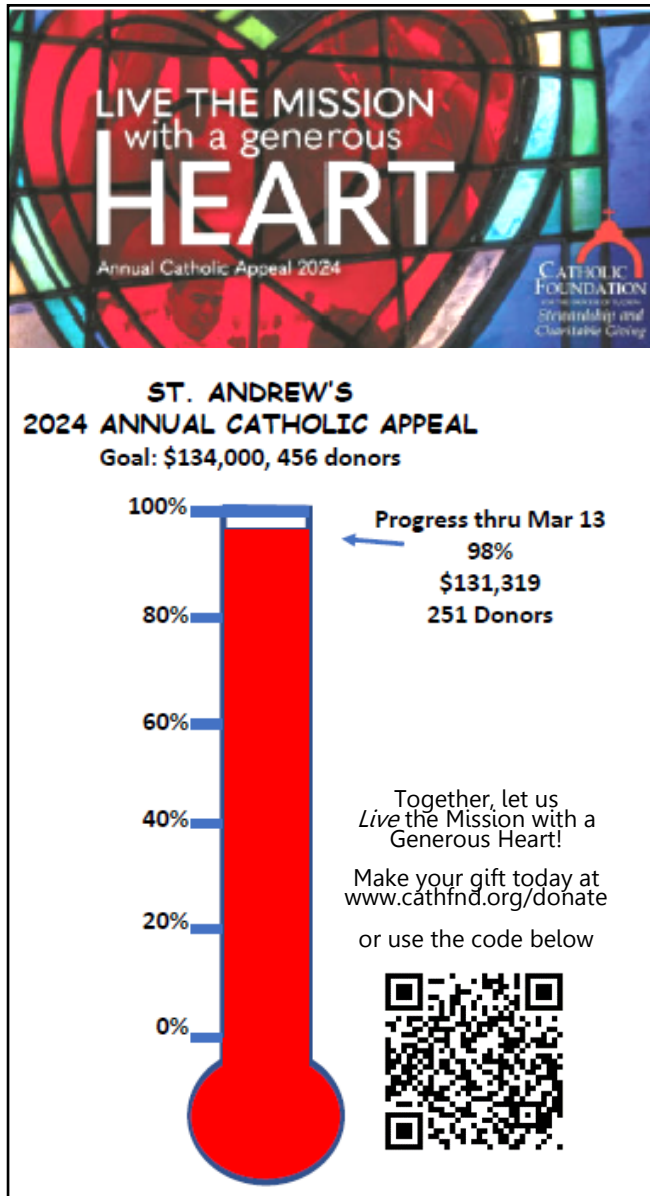
1. Do you get tongue-tied before the Blessed Sacrament?

**GriefShare** is a nationwide biblical support group that is focused on helping people who are dealing with a loved one's death. Each DVD session features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories, followed by small group discussion about the topics presented (with workbook support). The workbook also provides a brief daily Bible study.

At each **GriefShare** session you will find encouragement and help in grieving the death of your loved one. No matter the cause of your loved one's death, this is an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling. You will learn how to recognize the symptoms of being stuck in grief and how to cope with the normal emotions that come when grieving a death. You will learn valuable information on facing life situations, and you'll gain renewed hope for the future. These sessions are open to anyone regardless of whether your experience is recent or not so recent.

The group is led by individuals who have personally experienced grief due to a loved one's death. Each leader is trained in facilitating a **GriefShare** support group. Our **GriefShare** group meets every Wednesday from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in Madonna Hall room #3. We hope you will consider joining us.

Please remember your loss is shared by others in this church and what you are experiencing is sometimes easier to bear knowing others are listening and do care.

May God's love continue to comfort and strengthen you.

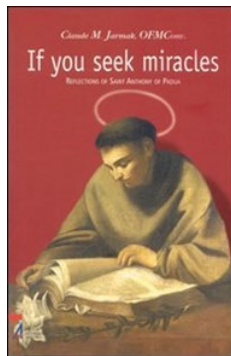
## SCAM ALERT

## From your Parish Library

### ***If You Seek Miracles –***

***Reflections of Saint Anthony of Padua*** by Claude M. Jarmak is an aid for reflective prayer, a resource for preaching and teaching, and a reference for Franciscan spirituality. 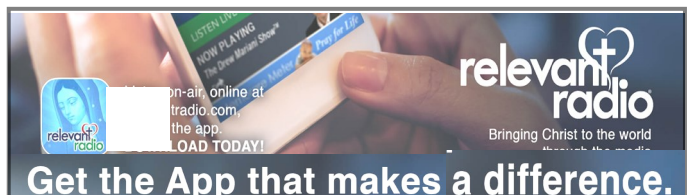

Linda called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and Fr. Greg led the group in an opening prayer.

Minutes from the February meeting were approved as written.

**Finance** (Kate): EXCUSED Finance Report for February was sent to the Council via email.

**Music Ministry** (Michelle): Still working Organ tuning contract, more information at April Council meeting. The 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Concert series will take place Sunday, 17 March 2024 at 2pm. A newspaper digital ad was submitted. The 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Concert series will feature organist Doug Lightenheimer. "Patriotic Pipes" Concert will take place in July. The Organ Committee received an \$8K donation, and \$10K has been repaid to the Building Fund for the loan to repair/upgrade the organ.

**Building and Grounds** (Maryann): Researching the installation of automatic lighting for the Church restrooms. Hot water in Church restrooms out and will be repaired. AC ducts in Rectory cleaned. An estimate to have Kino and Madonna Hall ducts cleaned is being sought. Heating at Good Shepard Mission was restored. Research on replacement flooring for Madonna Hall is underway. This expense will be in the Capital expense budget for FY2025. A motion was approved to purchase of 15, 8-person round tables w/carts for use in Kino and Madonna Halls, at a cost not to exceed \$3K.

**St Vincent de Paul Society** (Pauline) EXCUSED her report was given by Ann D: Received \$20K in Safeway gift cards. Additionally, received \$20K grant. Food Bank served 3,355 family members (50% being children) with 946 food boxes. The Thrift Store is seeking a building permit for a metal canopy for the back of the store, a benefactor is sponsoring the entire project.

**Annual Catholic Appeal Update** (Ann and Maryann): The donations are currently at \$128,532 of the \$134,000 or 96% of our goal.

**Our Lady of the Sierras** (Charlie): The Board has expanded and now includes Our Lady of the Mountain's parishioner, Andrew Kjolsrud. The Retreat Center is well-booked and planning for the 2024 Christmas event is underway.

**Good Shepherd** (Chuck): Thanks were expressed for the maintenance team's repair of the heater.

**Ladies of St. Andrew** (Fran): EXCUSED No report.

**Seminarian Update** (Carlos): EXCUSED No report.

**Fr. Samuel** expressed his thanks to the Parish and provided a reminder that he will be serving at the San Solano Missions the weekends of 16/17 and 30/31 (Easter) March.

**Fr. Greg** commented on the start of the Lenten Mission w/Fr. Richard and the Lenten Penance Service. Seminarian Carlos is doing an outstanding job connecting with our young people during his time with us. We are identifying leaders who will step up and continue this work (especially with Altar Servers) when Carlos departs. The "Seekers" group of young men exploring/discerning vocations, will meet with Diocesan Vocations Director, Fr. Alan, on 21 March.


