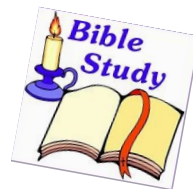

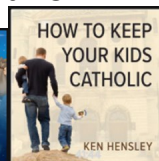

DID YOU KNOW.....

that we are very encouraged and grateful to all of our wonderful Volunteers, who are participating in the new Safe Environment training/registration?

Our Diocese is preparing for a National audit of Safe Environment compliance, and as part of their compliance procedures, have changed the two-tier requirements for our Volunteer which had been in place.

Previously, we had a "high level" group of Volunteers (those working directly with children, teens, and vulnerable adults), and a "low level" group of Volunteers (those serving in a variety of public ministries, such as Parish/Finance Council Members, Lectors, Sacristans, Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist at weekend Masses).

In the past two years, 40 complaints of violations of Safe Environment standards have been received and processed by the Diocesan Safe Environment Office. All of these violations were made by "low level" Volunteers. (For example, a "low level" Volunteer (in Tucson) failed to report that he had been convicted of a sex crime and was now a registered offender!)

In response to this situation, the Diocese of Tucson eliminated the "low level" category, requiring all Volunteers to be cleared at the higher level of compliance! No one is 'exempt' – our Clergy and our Staff are also required to be fully compliant.

While this has been an inconvenience for all of us, there has been wonderful cooperation on the part of most of our Volunteers, in helping us move to this new level of compliance, following the Diocesan requirements! (Many of our Volunteers have had top security clearances for their military or civil service careers, so such background checks and clearance procedures are nothing new.)

We regret that a few of our wonderful Volunteers found the new requirements to be too much of a burden, and we do regret your stepping down from your Ministries, and greatly appreciate your many years of faithful service in our Parish! It is, very much, our loss.

Lupita Teran is our Parish Compliance Officer, and she does a great job, helping our Volunteers navigate through the new Diocesan requirements – having to patiently explain that these new requirements are Diocesan mandated, and without full-compliance our insurance coverage will be forfeited!

It is a sad reality for all of us that these measures are necessary, but it was only 40 years ago that very serious incidents of abuse of minors took place here at St. Andrew's and the pain for the victims and their families is still a horrible reality for them. Vigilance is the price that we all have to pay to keep children, teens, and vulnerable adults safe – always!

Thank you to all of our wonderful Volunteers, and thank you for your understanding as we move into this new reality of Parish life!

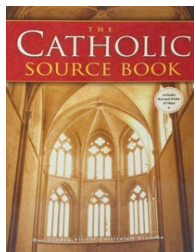

CATHOLIC QUIZ: *This week's Question: "What is 'Expectation Week'?"*



The answer to last week's Question: "When was the celebration of the Ascension moved from Thursday to the following Sunday and why?" The Feast of the Ascension, marking the 40th day after Christ's Resurrection, always falls on a Thursday – this year 26 May (like Easter, it is a "moveable" Feast). Formerly, the Paschal Candle was extinguished on the Feast of the Ascension, representing the physical departure of Christ from the earth. Since 2001, in the United States, this Feast may now be celebrated on the following Sunday, the Seventh Sunday of Easter. Because of the importance of the Feast of the Ascension, a Holy Day of Obligation, the Bishops of the United States sought to move the celebration from the weekday to the following Sunday, in order that more of the Faithful could participate in its observance. Some Dioceses in the United States, have opted to keep the celebration on the Thursday – the 40th day. Now, the Paschal Candle remains lit through Pentecost, for the entire Easter Season.

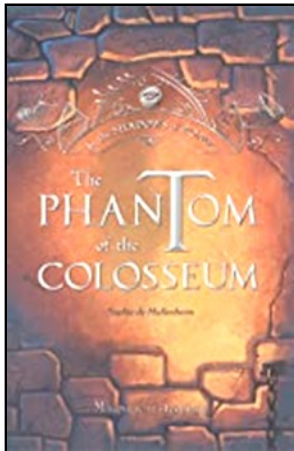
Bookkeeper note:

Finance Council Meeting Minutes
May 17th, 2022, 5:30 p.m.**

Fr. Greg called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and led the group in an opening prayer.

Minutes from the April 2022 meeting were approved as written.

Finance (Kate): Income for April was \$84,247 of which \$2,371 were designated to Good Shepherd Mission. Expenses were \$77,640. The Parish general fund level is \$511,410.

The Building Our Church fund balance is \$69,533. The Council reviewed the FY 2023 proposed budget in advance of next month's vote.

Hispanic Ministry (Lupita): The Hispanic Group meets once a month for faith sharing.

A specific topic is chosen for these monthly discussions. Fr. Marco celebrated a charismatic healing Mass on Monday, May 9th, which was well attended. Amy and Augustin Martinez are new parishioners working to schedule Marriage Encounter sessions for both St. Andrew and Our Lady of the Mountains.

Ladies of St. Andrew (Fran): The Ladies hosted the annual "Baby Shower for Baby Jesus". The American Heritage Girls were a great help in organizing the gifts and helping the party go smoothly.

Knights of Columbus and St. Paul Street Evangelization (Ed): The Knights State Convention will be held on May 22nd and May 23rd. The Evangelization team will be focusing on Vocations at the event. There will be a barbecue at Sacred Heart Parish in Tombstone on May 29th as a recruiting drive for the Knights in that Parish. Highway clean-up is on the calendar for June 11th. Council elections are on June 14th.

All Saints School (Mike): Enrollment for the next school year is currently at 79, with a goal of 115. Two 8th graders this year will advance to Buena High School.

Our Lady of the Sierras (Charlie): The new managing director will assume her duties on the first week of July, working with the current manager for three months. New books of Pat Chouinard's messages have been translated, printed in Spanish and will be distributed at no cost. The retreat center calendar still has openings, and the aforementioned Marriage Encounter team will explore using the facility. The Bishop of Nogales is a frequent visitor to the Shrine and plans to attend this year's Christmas Mass again.

Catholic Foundation News and Ignatian Retreat News (Ann): A strategic planning group met today via Zoom. The Redemptorist Renewal Center has strict vaccination protocols for attendance at the Ignatian Retreat which is affecting sign-up.

Organ Refurbishment Update (Michelle): The refurbishment is on target to be completed at the end of October. Plans are in place to start a series of organ recitals after the first of the year.

Building and Grounds (Maryann): Old West Cleaning completed the carpet and upholstery cleaning at Good Shepherd Mission. Cactus Wren pre-school intends to change the point of entry to the back gate which will ease congestion in the main parking area in front of the admin building. There is one year left on their lease. Maintenance staff will be cleaning and sorting the music room. The Community Chorus donated to the Parish and wrote a card expressing their gratitude for the ability to use the facilities. Buena High School echoed the sentiment in a recent meeting. Fr. Greg thanked Maryann for being the outreach person to the Community to coordinate so many events in Kino Hall. The committee is still gathering and reviewing bids for the replacement of the heating and cooling system in Kino Hall. Toilet replacement discussed at last month's meeting will be done in phases over the next year. The American Heritage girls will do a deep-clean of Kino Hall in July. Under discussion is a proposal to trade the boom lift for a scissor lift to increase maneuverability inside the Church.

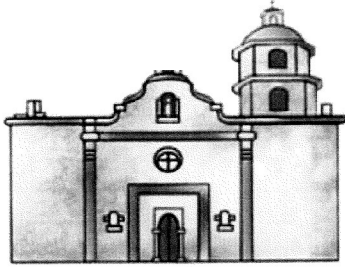
Annual Catholic Appeal (Maryann): Les Orchekowsky will speak at the Masses next weekend to thank the Parishioners and wrap up the campaign.

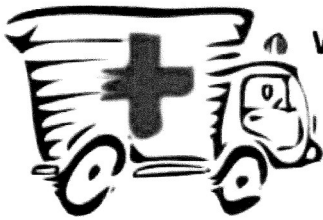
Fr. Greg adjourned the meeting at 6:49 p.m. and led the group in a closing prayer.
