

DID YOU KNOW....

that we are in the midst of some important maintenance for our sixteen-year-old church? We are very grateful to *Rusty Rivera* and his great crew from "Old West Cleaning", who have completed the huge task of cleaning the upholstery in the pews, kneelers, chairs, and carpeting in the church – you have probably noticed the change of color to a richer blue, with sixteen years' of dust and grime removed! What a great improvement!

A much larger and more complicated maintenance issue concerns our pipe organ – the largest in Cochise County – a 73 year-old instrument, installed in 2008. Our Moller organ was originally in a Baptist church in Racine, Wisconsin, and was purchased for our new church and rebuilt by Organ Builder Michael O'Sullivan. The organ is listed in the U.S. Historical Registry of Pipe Organs, and has been featured in a number of newspaper articles, and, of course, is the 'star' of the various concerts and music programs (Community Hymn Festival, Messiah) for the wider community!

An "Organ Committee", made up of Michelle Mitchell, Rebecca Williams, Kathleen O'Brien, Billie Hayes, Maryann Hockstad, Wes Moulton, and Isaac McDowell, are working with Master Organ Builder Grahame Davis of Tucson, to work on proposals, to be presented to the Parish/Finance Council. The Committee is also working on securing grants to help fund the cost of the needed upgrades. Please watch this space for more information!





This Week's Question: "What are the 'other names' for the Fourth Sunday in Lent?"

The Answer to last week's Question: "What is the 'Penitential' nature of Lent?" Because the Lenten Season is Scripturally based on JESUS' forty days of fasting and temptation in the Wilderness, AND because these forty days are the step-by-step preparation period for the Catechumens, those being initiated into the Church through Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist, AND because these forty days allowed those who were excommunicated to do public penance and be re-admitted to the Sacraments at Easter, Lent has a 'Penitential' nature: turning away from sin and addiction to sin, seeking God's help and the prayers of the Faithful, to be reconciled to God and to the Church, renewing one's own Baptismal covenant through personal conversion, and recommitment to full discipleship.

All of this marks the attitude of a "Penitent": one who has expressed sorrow for their sins, has decided to leave those sins behind, and is walking in the newness of grace through forgiveness. Because it is a "Penitential" Season — it begins with ashes placed upon the head or the face: an ancient symbol for deep remorse or sorrow! The liturgical color for Lent is, of course, violet, the color designated for sorrow, penitence, and preparation. Violet-colored stoles are used for the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) for this same reason!



The Transfiguration of Jesus

Genesis 15:5-12, 17-18; Psalm 27:1,7-8, 8-9, 13-14; Philippians 3:17-4:1; Luke 9:28b-36

Seeing God's glory

"Becoming fully awake, they saw his glory". —Ľuke 9:32

At the Transfiguration, Peter, John and

James saw a fleeting glimpse of Our Lord's amazing glory. They immediately wanted to put up some tents to mark the spot. God stopped that idea. Today, however, God's glory is often blocked by tall structures of glass, steel and concrete. In some place, buildings make it impossible to even see the dawn or the sunset. God told Abram, "Look up at the sky and count the stars if you can" (Gn 15:5). Yet, inmost metropolitan areas, too much artificial light blocks out the vast number of stars. We need to wake up to the many ways we number of stars. We need to wake up to the many ways we are blocking the glory of God in our world today.

How can we fast this week?

Try to give up a little sleep or screen time to go out and see the glory of God in the heavens. Make time and find a place to walk in the dawn, bask in the sunset or gaze up at the stars in the night sky. Notice that the sun is always more glorious when there are a few clouds at the dawn or dusk. So, it is in our own lives. God's glory is more beautifully appreciated when we face our own clouds on life's road.

How can we pray this week?

How can we give this week?
