DID YOU KNOW....

that this coming Saturday, 20 January, is the March For Life in Tucson – beginning with Mass at *St. Augustine Cathedral!* Being “Pro-Life” is much, much more than a political position. 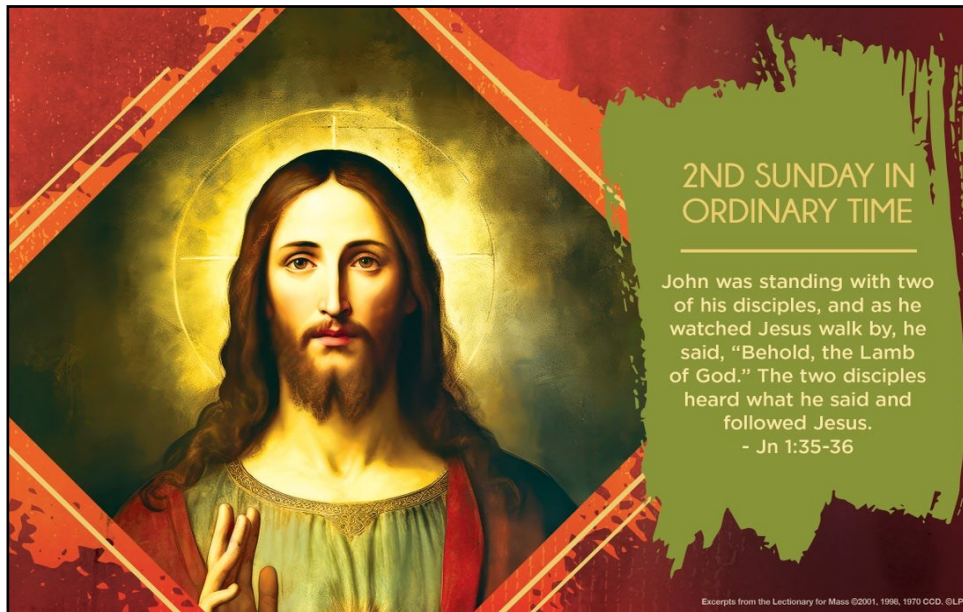

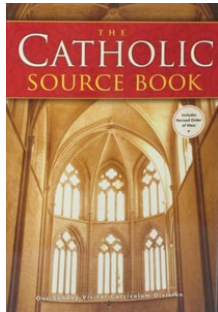

CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "What are the 'Month's Dedication'?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "Why is the year designated "A.D."?" It was not until the Sixth Century that each year (Latin: annus) would be called Domini – 'of the Lord'. It was the idea of Dionysius Exiguus, a Sixth Century Byzantine monk, to make the Incarnation the centerpiece of history for the Christian world. The time before Christ's birth would be a count-down to Christmas; the time after, a count up. The change from A.M. (Anno Mundi – 'year of the world') to A.D. did not come overnight. The precise Anno Domini in which we now live is based on the supposed year that Christ was born – according to Brother Dionysius. Modern scholarship holds that the actual birth was several years earlier, between 7 B.C. and 4 B.C. – based on the death of Herod the Great (Matthew 2:19) or, more precisely, 6 B.C. – based on the great taxation of Quirinius (Luke 2:1-2).

- If the abuse happened in Arizona, call the Police or Sheriff's Office in the specific area.
- If the abuse happened in any other state, call the Police or Sheriff's Office in the specific area of that state.
- Call the diocese in which the abuse happened.

If the abuse happened in the Diocese of Tucson, call the Victim Assistance Program of the Diocese of Tucson at **520-623-0344** (1-800-234-0344 in Arizona) and/or the Office of Child, Adolescent and Adult Protection of the Diocese of Tucson at **520-838-2513**.

The Supreme Court's decision in *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* ended the nearly fifty-year nationwide reign of abortion on-demand that was ushered in by *Roe v. Wade* in 1973. In this monumental legal victory, the Supreme Court rightly concluded that there is nothing in the Constitution's text, history, American legal tradition, or the Court's precedents that prevents the government from protecting preborn children in the womb from the violence of abortion. *Dobbs* returned the issue of abortion to the people's elected representatives at the federal and state levels. And as we have seen, continuing work is needed to protect children, women, and families from the tragedy of abortion.

We must continue advocating for pro-life laws and policies, especially at the state and local levels. Abortion is legal in more states than not, with many working to expand and enshrine abortion protections. In addition to our efforts to protect human life in law, we must also help women facing unexpected or difficult pregnancies, offering them the compassionate support they need to lovingly

welcome the gift of their children. We must do whatever we can in every sphere to ensure the flourishing of both mothers and their children throughout life's journey.
