DID YOU KNOW....

that a 'bi-partisan' Bill was introduced in the State Legislature to remove the statue of *Padre Eusebio Kino* from the Hall of Statuary in our Nation's capital and replace it with a statue of Justice Sandra Day O'Connor?

While the late Justice O'Connor and her accomplishments should receive wider acclamation, especially by her fellow-Arizonans, many felt that it need not be at the loss of the acknowledgment of *Padre Kino's* singular and pioneering impact on the history of Arizona, especially in light of his well attested efforts at building bridges of understanding between the Native Peoples and the European settlers in our region.

A zealous missionary and explorer and cartographer, *Padre Kino* literally put Arizona 'on the map'.

A pioneer cattleman, 'agricultural agent' who introduced European/Mexican fruits and vegetables to the Sonoran Desert Peoples, he famously introduced winter wheat, all of which broke the 'feast-famine' cycle. Above all, he was a tireless defender of the dignity and rights of the Native Americans, who welcomed him and the message of the Gospel into their villages.

When the statue of *Padre Kino* was dedicated on 14 February 1965, *Senator Carl Hayden*, in his speech accepting the statue, said in part: *"Here then we have a fortunate glance at the Arizona of nearly three centuries ago and of the man who first made it known to the civilized world – a kindly man of extraordinary intellect, unwavering in purpose and possessed of faith that inspired faith in others."*

In accepting this statute for Americans everywhere, I thank God for blessing this country of ours with men like Father Kino. They are our everlasting heritage."

In July 2023, *Pope Francis* acknowledged to holiness of *Padre Kino*, declaring him "Venerable"- the next step toward Canonization!

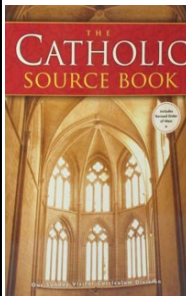
We have our own statue of *Padre Kino*, holding his astrolabe with which he charted the skies and the desert, on the south façade of the church, and there is a stained-glass window of the "*Padre on Horseback*" in Kino Hall!

Many groups came together to protest the removal of *Padre Kino's* statue from the Hall of Statuary and to defend our Catholic and Hispanic heritage, and his legacy of building bridges of understanding between people, and last Wednesday, the Bill to remove his statue was defeated 38-21!

We are also looking forward to our special Concert in honor of *Padre Kino* here in St. Andrew's on Sunday, March 17th with the beautiful music of Vespers, composed and directed by *Carlos Zapien* and featuring the Cathedral Schola!

CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "What is 'Mothering Sunday'?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "Can Baptisms take place in Lent?" Normally, baptisms are not celebrated in Lent, but rather are delayed until the Easter Season. If there is sufficient reason, however, such as illness of the child, or other circumstances, then Baptism may be celebrated, even in Lent. (Because we are in a military community, where sometimes travel needs make the delay of Baptism difficult – and we would now extend that to the travel needs of godparents, who unlike the 'old days' very often live a great distances – the celebration of Baptism can take place in Lent, in light of 'special circumstances'.) However, the 'normal practice' is to wait until Lent is over and celebrate Baptism in the Easter Season!

REFLECT

On March 25, 2020, the Church celebrated the 25th anniversary of the papal encyclical *Evangelium vitae* (*The Gospel of Life*). This prophetic document, written by Pope St. John Paul II, reaffirmed the Church's constant teaching on the value and inviolability of every human life.

The Gospel of Life highlights the special and particular role of women in bearing the gift of life. St. John Paul II offers heartfelt thanks to "heroic mothers," who, placing their trust in God, "devote themselves to their own family without reserve, who suffer in giving birth to their children and who are ready to make any effort, to face any sacrifice, in order to pass on to them the best of themselves" (EV 86). The Holy Father also outlines many challenges that expectant mothers may face, recognizing that an "unborn child is totally entrusted to the protection and care of the woman carrying him or her in the womb" (EV 58). For this reason, it is particularly important that the Church come alongside mothers, offering encouragement, assistance, and support that is life-affirming for both them and their children.
