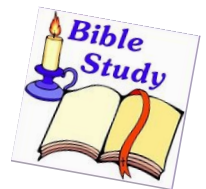

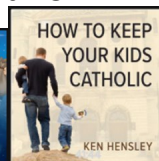

that our Parish has a very active "Buildings and Grounds Committee"?

Maryann Hockstad (chair), Gene Mundt, James Harper, Tom Felix, Deacon Joe Kushner, Dan Pierce, and our Maintenance Crew, Ben Horner and Michael Prostka meet monthly to assess needs, assign priorities, and recommend to our Parish/Finance Council various improvements, repairs, and up-grades to our two-campus Parish.

Maintenance is a huge issue for such a large facility, and we are very grateful to Ben Horner, Michael Protska, and Mark Williams for their outstanding service!

Each month, immediate, as well as long-term projects are discussed and prioritized.


Some of the on-going projects being planned are: the relocation of the "Knights' Way" (Memorial for deceased members of the Knights of Columbus from the traffic island in the North parking lot to the 'placita' in front of Madonna Hall, new air conditioning system for Kino Hall, cleaning and repairing of the pews in the church, recoating the church roof, the painting of the new block fence around the Cactus Wren Pre-school playground, and a number of other projects! Our artist/maintenance man, Michael Prostka, is also doing repairs to chipped and broken tiles in the church. Tom Felix has been repairing damaged areas on the pews! And, it must be said, our superb Maintenance Team: Ben Horner, Michael Protska, Mark Williams, and volunteer, Tom Felix, have saved the Parish many thousands of dollars through their "in house" repairs and on-line bargain hunting!

These improvements/upgrades and emergency repairs are all made possible, without the need for special "Second Collections", because of your consistent generous support of the "Building Our Church Fund".

This Fund – supported by your monthly envelope and special gifts –allows us to make certain that our "aging" two-campus Parish is kept safe, beautiful, and very well cared for! Your Buildings and Grounds Committee are excellent stewards of our Parish resources!

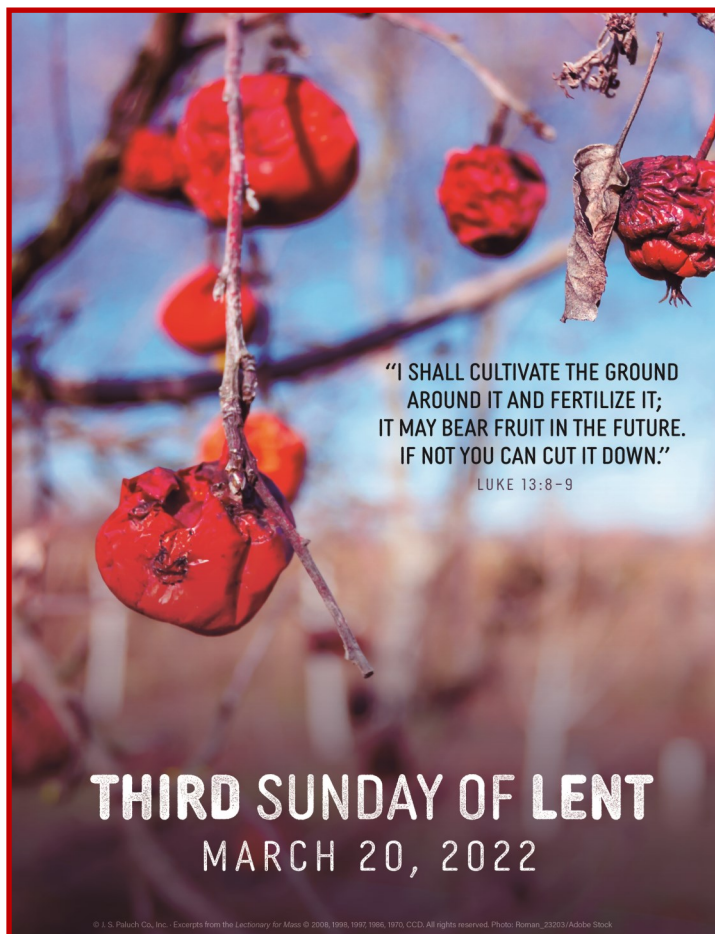

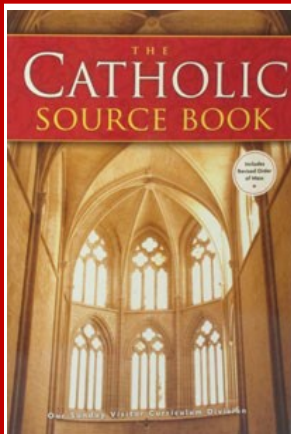

CATHOLIC QUIZ: This Week's Question: "This Week's Question: "What does the "I.N.R.I" inscription on the crucifix stand for?"

The Answer to last week's Question: "What are the 'aliases' for the Fourth Sunday in Lent?" The Fourth Sunday of Lent (27 March) has had many 'aliases': "Laetare Sunday", after the first words of the Introit: "Laetare Jerusalem" ('Rejoice with Jerusalem!') – the half-way point of Lent, and a respite in the penitential season, marked by rose-colored vestments, instead of violet. There is a joyful note at this point in Lent, because of the ancient practice of "handing over" the Apostles' Creed to Catechumens, the last and decisive step for those preparing for Baptism! It is also called "Mothering Sunday" from the ancient custom of visiting one's 'mother' church or cathedral, where one had been baptized. In the natural evolution of this pilgrimage, children would also return home to spend the day with mother, taking roses for her, because of the color of the vestments. One tradition presents "Mothering Sunday" as an honor to Saint Anne, the Blessed Mother's mother, when children would "go a'mothering" – the origin of our Mother's Day! – a day of family reunion and festivity. It is also called "Rose Sunday" – from the papal blessing of the golden rose, a symbol of spiritual joy. The golden rose was blessed by the Pope on the Fourth Sunday of Lent, and sent to some notable person or institution to acknowledge and honor special service. It was also called "Refection (Latin: refreshment) Sunday, and in some places special cakes were given as gifts, commemorating Joseph feeding his brothers (First Reading) and JESUS feeding the multitudes (Gospel). Each of these is a very nice custom and way of celebrating the "half-way point" of Lent – next Sunday!

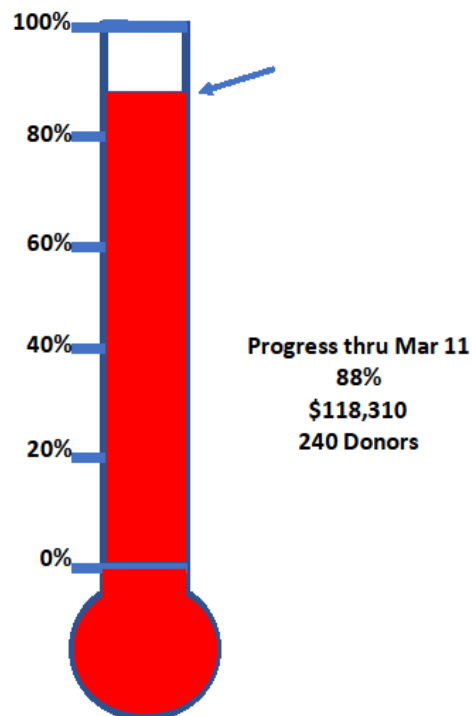

Walking Through The Weeks of **LENT**

MARCH 20 THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

The Samaritan woman

Exodus 17:3-7; Psalm 95:2-2,6-7,8-9; Romans 5:1-2, 5-8; John 4:5-42

Drinking from God's spring

"The water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

—John 4:14



A spring is a beautiful thing. Fresh, cool water endlessly bubbles up from the earth. People stop to drink from it, swim in it, be refreshed by it. Jesus promised the Samaritan woman that he would

make such a spring well up in each of us. Do we appreciate this gift? Do we sit quietly and let this sacred spring refresh us, wash over us, inspire us? Do we drink from these waters of eternal life? Or are we just too busy to even think about it?

How can we fast this week?

Sadly, fresh spring water is becoming scarce and polluted in our world today. Try to fast from wasting water. Let's use only the water we need and appreciate the great gift of it. Become more aware of the ways we waste water or let it run for no reason. Maybe take shorter but more prayerful showers.

How can we pray this week?

The psalms are the living springs of our faith — the oldest and most beautiful prayers we have, yet still fresh, bubbling and inspiring. The Sunday psalms for Lent are Psalms 91, 27, 95, 34, 126 and 22. Pray them and be refreshed by them. Then start working your way through all 150 psalms. Each is beautiful in its own way.

How can we give this week?

Let's give the gift of water to the thirsty and food to the hungry. Most parishes regularly collect nonperishable food items for the needy. Pick up some bottled water and extra cans of soup and pasta during your weekly shopping and donate it to your parish or local food pantry. It will refresh you.
