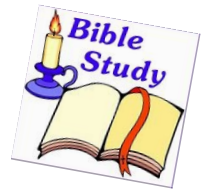

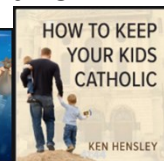
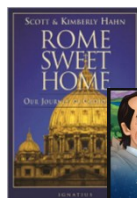

On Monday, from 5:00 to 8:00 PM, we will have our *ADVENT PENANCE CELEBRATION*, the opportunity to experience the Sacrament of Reconciliation, with a number of Priest/Confessors at your service! Confessors will be available at any time you choose during the three hours, beginning at 5:00.

The main emphasis of the Season of Advent is *preparation*, and there is no more important preparation for the Holy Days than preparing our souls! Please take some time to download a good examination of conscience – available also on our website and flocknotes – and prepare your heart for this life-giving, life-shaping Encounter with the Lord of Mercy!

AND, next Saturday, the 17th, you are invited to join in the “first annual” Community *Posadas*, which will take place on West End of Fry Blvd – starting at 7:00 PM near *Dominos* and processing – with music – to *Julie and Sammy’s Ice Cream Shop*, for the conclusion with hot chocolate and goodies! *Posadas* (“shelters”) is a beautiful Mexican Advent tradition, which marks with song and procession, the journey of Mary and Joseph, seeking shelter for the birth of the Holy Child. We, with several other organizations, want to make this beautiful tradition available to the wider Community, and to put the Gospel on the streets! Please join us for this hour of sharing our Faith and experiencing the richness of our Hispanic culture! Dress warmly! Candles will be provided, as well as bi-lingual worship aids!

AND, next Sunday, 18 December, at 7:00PM, the Advent and Christmas portions of Handel’s *MESSIAH*, will be performed in our own Sanctuary! Again this year, it will be under the capable direction of *Reynaldo Romo*, (Music Director at Our Lady of the Mountains), and accompanied by Master Organist, *Billy Hayes*, and a community Choir and soloists, which includes many of our own parishioners! This powerful ‘Gospel written in music’ will lift your heart and spirit for the true celebration of Christmas! 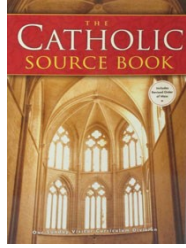

The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is 'Gaudete Sunday'?" 'Gaudete' is the Latin word: "Rejoice!" The Third Sunday of Advent, celebrates the joyful note of anticipation for the coming Feast, in a season that was traditionally seen as penitential. The liturgical color for 'Gaudete Sunday' is Rose – used on this Sunday, and on the other "rejoice Sunday" in the middle of the penitential Season of Lent!

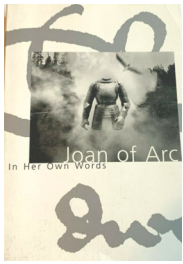

*Las Posadas, celebrated yearly from December 16-24, is a religious festival traditionally held in Mexico and parts of Latin America. Translating to "The Inns" in Spanish, Las Posadas is an important part of the Christmas festivities. Over the nine nights of celebrations, parties are held at different people's homes. Before each gathering, all the guests form a procession to mark Mary and Joseph's search for an inn on the night of Jesus' birth. The march is usually led by an angel as a symbolic act of Mary and Joseph finding shelter in a stable when they were unable to find lodging in Bethlehem. The parties are joyous occasions, including prayers, food, music, fireworks, and piñatas!

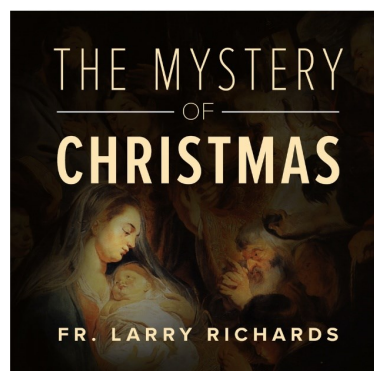
