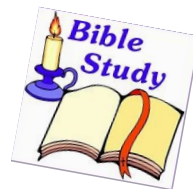

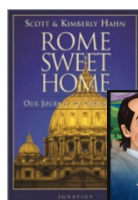

## DID YOU KNOW.....

that the Mass is the 'summit and source' of our lives as Catholic Christians, and that the jewel of the Mass has a 'setting'?

The 'setting' for the Mass is the sacred realm of 'hospitality'. The word 'hospitality' has the same root as the words "hospital", "hospice", and "hostel"! The word means "to care for" or "to provide for the necessities of another". A very rich word, indeed! In the Sacred Scriptures and the culture of the Mid-East, even today, hospitality is not simply a social nicety, but a sacred duty! Think of the many stories in the Scriptures of people extending hospitality and receiving a blessing as a result – Abraham and the Three Heavenly Visitors (*Genesis 18:1-10*) and the two on the road to Emmaus, who invited the Stranger to dine with them (*Luke 24*)! In the *Letter to the Hebrews (13:2)* we read: *"Do not neglect hospitality, for some have entertained angels without knowing it!"*

When we practice hospitality, such as letting a stranger sit in 'our pew' or welcoming a visitor, or offering some small assistance, we are creating that environment of "caring for" which is the setting of the Mass! When you are asked to greet those around you, this is not an 'interruption' in your preparation for Mass, it is an important part of that preparation!

Ours is a culture which has largely lost the sense and the spirit of hospitality, and isolation and 'distancing' have become the norm for many.

It cannot be so among us, if we are to be a true community – a communion in the fullest sense of that word!

Each time that we come together, we continue to build community with visitors and those we see every week at church, and then become part of the great communion (community) of saints, through the action of the Mass.

Put on the largest 'screen' – the Holy Mass is itself the 'hospitality' of God – the expression of God's caring for us and providing for our salvation, inviting us to His Table and offering us the Bread of Life! And just as in the sense of "hospital" – where people are cared for, they are healed!

Those who welcome our visitors and guests are not "ushers" – as you would encounter in a theater – but, rather "ministers of hospitality" and "ministers of first impressions" – who, on behalf of all of us, extend practical care for others, through their welcoming presence.

But all of us are called to the "ministry of hospitality" and each of us has the sacred duty to personally extend God's care for our brothers and sisters! Something to think about!

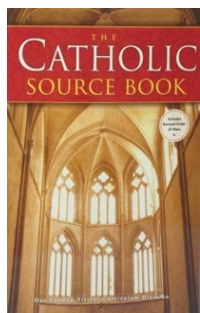

On 10 August AD 258, the Deacon Lawrence was bound to a gridiron and burned to death. As has been repeated so often, he asked to be turned when "one side was done" – a martyr's humor! It so happens that on the three nights following this Martyr's Feast Day each year, the early morning sky is streaked with one of the most spectacular meteorite showers of the year. Such celestial sights were never meaningless to the medieval mind: these "falling stars" were called the "tears of Saint Lawrence," spangling the sky like glimmering tears, shed from heaven for the cruelty of humankind!

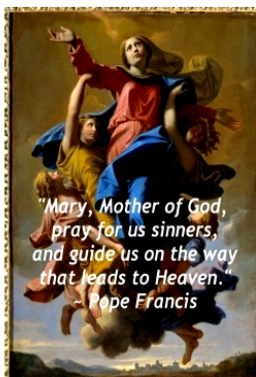

If Jeffrey Newell presents himself to you or anyone else as a priest, please be aware that he has been suspended from the priesthood, is not in good standing, and has had credible allegations of misconduct reported against him, which he has admitted.
