The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is the Penitential Observance of Lent?"

Historically, Lent was the retreat-like final preparation for catechumens, those being initiated into the Church at the Easter Vigil. At a later time, it also became a period of fasting and prayer for those, who through serious sin, had been excluded from Communion and were doing public penance for those sins, so that they could be re-admitted to Communion at Easter. Naturally enough, it became a time of spiritual renewal for all the Faithful – inspired by the conversion of the catechumens and the 're-conversion' of the excommunicated. The whole Church came to adapt Lent as a 'penitential season', whereby all of the Faithful imitated the catechumens, in their desire for full-participation and inclusion, and the penitents, in their sorrow for the choosing of sin, and their 'reconciliation' with God and the Church! for fasting. 'Mardi Gras' or 'Fat Tuesday' comes from this 'feast before the fast'!



Jesus and the Jewish Roots of the Eucharist by Brant





Dr. Pitre explores ancient Jewish beliefs about the Passover of the Messiah, the miraculous Manna from heaven, and the mysterious Bread of the presence. As he shows, these three keys – the Passover, the Manna, and the Bread of the Presence – have the power to unlock the original meaning of the Eucharistic words of Jesus. Along the way, Pitre also explains how Jesus united the Last Supper to

his death on Good Friday and his Resurrection on Easter Sunday.”
