DID YOU KNOW...

that we completed a SECOND Mission Project this year???

In January we announced that our Mission Project for 2023 would be to raise funds for the completion of the Rectory/Parish Office in *Fr. Samuel's* home village in Nigeria. That Project was to cost \$15,000 and we planned to raise that money over a period of 6-8 months. Because of your extraordinary generosity and love for the Universal Church, the entire amount was raised in January and the Project completed in April! You have read *Fr. Samuel's* very moving and gracious 'thank you' to you all printed in the bulletin a few months ago!

But wait, there's more. . . *Fr. Simon Muema* asked if before his transfer to Tucson he could request Mission support for a project in his hometown in Kenya. The project was to construct a dormitory for children attending school from outlying villages. It was explained that we had completed this year's Mission Project, but that he could certainly put in a request for 2024.

Fr. Simon then asked if there would be any problem directing any gifts that people might want to give him at the Ice Cream Social before he left for Tucson to this project.

This, of course, was fine, and his request was shared with the parishioners here and at *Our Lady of the Mountains*, where he has been in residence this past year.

In his last week with us over \$17,000 was given – almost the total amount needed to complete the entire project! *Our Lady of the Mountains* parishioners donated \$4,985, *Deacon Michael* and *Helen Denton* very graciously hosted a potluck/fundraiser in their home that netted \$4,520, and donations at the Ice Cream Social hosted by our *Knights of Columbus*, totaled \$7,570!

Fr. Simon stated that this amount was far beyond his expectations and how sincerely he appreciates the kindness and generosity shown by all to him!

This was an outstanding expression of love and an "extra mile" effort on the part of so many parishioners and groups! You truly have a heart for missions and a global vision of the Universal Church, proven again, by a SECOND successful Mission Project in 2023!

We add our heartfelt thanks to you along with those of *Fr. Simon Muema* for your generous response! You certainly live the truth that *Catholics measure wealth by generosity not by accumulation!*

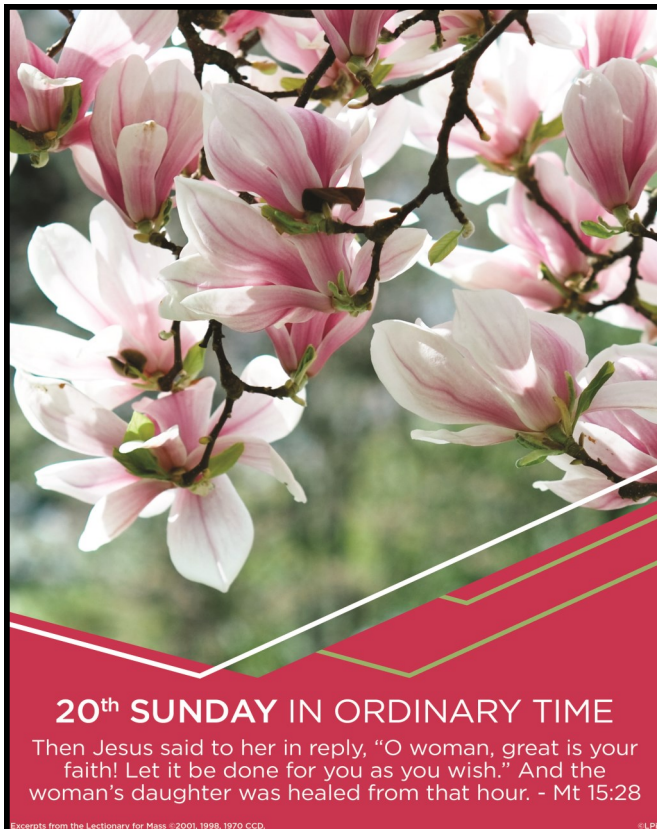

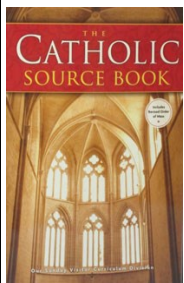

The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What are the 'Tears of Saint Lawrence'?"

On August 10, AD 258, the Deacon Lawrence was bound to a gridiron and burned to death. As has been repeated so often, he asked to be turned when "one side was done" – a martyr's humor! It so happens that on the three nights following this Martyr's Anniversary each year, the early morning sky is streaked with one of the most spectacular meteorite showers of the year: 'the *Perseid Meteor Shower*', which climax in mid-August each year! Such celestial sights were never without meaning to the medieval mind: these "falling stars" were called the "tears of Saint Lawrence," spangling the sky like glimmering tears, shed from heaven for the cruelty of humankind!

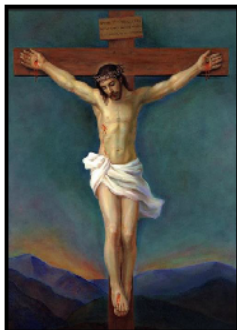

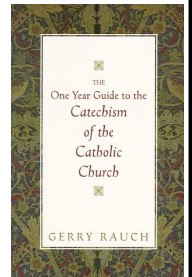

“Sharing the Land of Canaan”

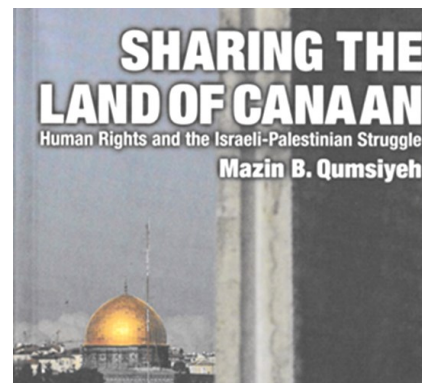

- Learn about the struggle of Palestinians and Israelis to arrive at a status of peaceful co-existence in the Holy Land.
- Receive an update on **Bethlehem University's** Palestinian Institute for BioDiversity and Sustainability and its Museum of Natural History (similar to the Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum in Tucson). The institute has developed very quickly in the past two years to become the major institution in West Asia tackling climate change and other threats to our environment.

Professor Qumsiyeh is the founder and Director of the Institute and Museum. A geneticist and environmentalist, he has been a professor at Duke, Yale, Tennessee, and Bethlehem Universities. While at Yale, Mazin wrote the fascinating book, ***Sharing the Land of Canaan: Human Rights and the Israeli-Palestinian Struggle***.

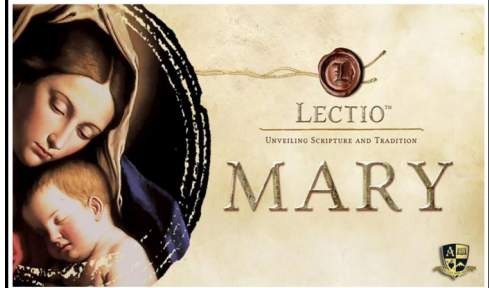

Each DVD session features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories, followed by small group discussion about the topics presented (with workbook support). At each GriefShare session you will find encouragement and help in grieving the death of your loved one. No matter the cause of your loved one's death, this is an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling. You will learn how to recognize the symptoms of being stuck in grief and how to cope with the normal emotions that come when grieving a death. You will learn valuable information on facing life situations, and you'll gain renewed hope for the future. These sessions are open to anyone regardless of whether your experience is recent or not so recent. The group is led by individuals who have personally experienced grief due to a loved one's death. Each leader is trained in facilitating a GriefShare support group.

Our GriefShare group meets every Wednesday, 5 p.m.to 7:00 p.m. in Madonna Hall, room #3.

We hope you will consider joining us. Please remember your loss is shared by others in this church and what you are experiencing is sometimes easier to bear knowing others are listening and do care. May God's love continue to comfort and strengthen you.
