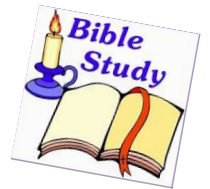

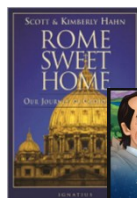

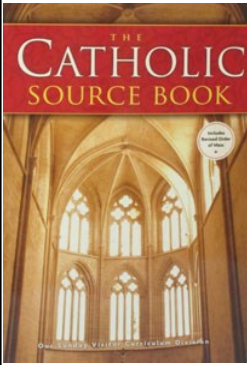

CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "What is the 'Power of the Keys'?"

The Answer to Last Week's Question: "Who was 'Pere Marquette'?"



A city in Michigan, lakes in Wisconsin, steamships, and even a railroad line serving the upper mid-west, were named for this intrepid Jesuit missionary/explorer! Born in France in 1637, he served in French Canada, founding the first European settlement in Michigan – Sault Ste. Marie. In 1673, *Pere* ('Father' in French) *Jacques Marquette* and layman *Louis Joliet*, and five other Frenchmen, began their expedition to explore the Mississippi River. Their two year missionary journey proved that the Mississippi flows south to empty in the Gulf of Mexico, rather than west to the Pacific, as was popularly thought! (Like his fellow Jesuit, *Padre Eusebio Francisco Kino*, he was first and foremost a missionary, seeking the salvation of souls – but the explorations that they made, in search of new Native Peoples to evangelize, changed the maps of the world!) *Pere Marquette* died on the return journey to Canada, but his travel diaries were carried back and carefully read!

Monthly recurring costs are only a part of our budget. Just like at your home, our Church roof suffers from the intense heat and sun damage here in our lovely town and will soon need a full re-coat. Our buildings age and require more frequent and intense repairs.

Federal and State legislation requires equitable wage and benefits for all of our VERY hard-working and dedicated staff.

In short, we survive and THRIVE because of YOUR donations. Please help us to serve you by sharing your resources with us. At a time when home dollars are stretched very thin, it is painful to have to ask all of you for an increase in giving, yet this is what we now must do in order to keep our Parish community operating.

HAND CARVED in BETHLEHEM

PLEASE STOP BY THE TABLES OF RELIGIOUS WARES (Nativity set, rosaries, statues, crucifixes, charms, etc.) AFTER ALL THE MASSES THE WEEKEND OF (May 13 & 14).

Ayman Khair is representing about 180 Christian families from Bethlehem. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East and the Pandemic, tourism has been stopped completely from March 2, 2020 till February 2022 and it is very slow now.

It is very important to support them at this critical time since they have no income and there is no government to take care of them and help them. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United State to purchase their articles.

These **hand carved religious articles are beyond description.** Carved from **wood of the sacred Olive tree**, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income are able to stay and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support.

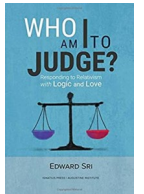
