



CATHOLIC QUIZ: This Week's Question: "What are the six "Wonders Created by the Hand of God?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is the 'Camino'?" The "Camino de Santiago" known in English as "The Way of Saint James," is a network of roads from the French Pyrenes across northern Spain leading to the shrine of the Apostle, St. James the Great, in in Galicia in northwestern Spain, where tradition has it that the remains of the saint are buried. During the Middle Ages, 'following the Camino' – was one of the three great pilgrimage experiences (with the Pilgrimages to the Holy Land and Rome). It's enormous popularity marked a number of Medieval practices and beliefs – and the "Milky Way" is still referred to as the "Camino de Santiago" in southern Europe! Today, it has once again found enormous appeal, as many modern pilgrims and "seekers" follow the ancient route as a form of spiritual path-finding or an 'extended retreat'.
