

#### DID YOU KNOW....

that next weekend we will be welcoming home *Father Anthony Corcoran*, one of our Parish's seven "Priest-Sons" now serving the Church?

Jesuit Father Anthony Corcoran, 59, is the Apostolic Administrator (missionary-bishop) of Kyrgyzstan in Central Asia. His appointment in 2017 came after serving the Church for 21 years in Russia, mainly in Siberia. The son of the late, beloved Bob and Elaine Corcoran, Fr. Anthony was the Vicar General (1999-2008) in Novosibirsk and Jesuit Major Superior in Moscow (2009-2017). The last time that Father Anthony was 'home' with us at St. Andrew's was in 2018!

Christianity in Kyrgyzstan dates back to 14th- and 15th-century Franciscan missionaries and, before that, to Nestorian settlers along the Silk Road. The first official Catholic parish was established in 1969. *Pope St. John Paul II* assigned the country to the Society of Jesus in the 1980s. Today, six priests and four nuns serve a community of between 600 and 1,500 Catholics nationwide. As a former republic of the Soviet Union, the Russian language is spoken throughout Kyrgyzstan. Like Siberia, the Catholic community in Kyrgyzstan includes many descendants of Communism's victims. Kyrgyzstan is a majority-Muslim country. On previous visits *Father Anthony* has shared powerful testimonies about the movement of the Holy Spirit among people in Central Asia and has stretched our imaginations to the other side of the world.

Asked in an interview what still surprises him about the Church, Pope Francis replied, "The faith of the holy People of God. There is a form of hidden holiness in the Church. There are heroes who set off on missions."

We would whole-heartedly agree with *Pope Francis* and have enormous respect and love for the Missionaries that we are privileged to partner with – around the world, and with our own *Fr. Samuel's 'Via Christi Community'*, 'missioning' among us!

Father Anthony will be present to preach at most of next weekend's Masses – and you will not want to miss the experience of being with one of the "heroes" of our Faith! Come and "welcome home" Fr. Anthony Corcoran! A special Collection will be taken at all of the Masses to support the Church in Kyrgyzstan!

A word of thanks to all who contributed so generously to the Ash Wednesday Collection for the *San Solano Missions*, serving the Native American *O'Odahm Reservation* west of Tucson!

Because of your generosity, we were able to send \$6500 to the Franciscan Fathers and Brothers serving the *San Solano Missions!* Thank you, so much!





#### CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "Why the Lenten fast from meat on Fridays?"




The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What is the Penitential Observance of Lent?" Historically, Lent was the retreat-like final preparation for catechumens, those being initiated into the Church at the Easter Vigil. At a later time, it also became a period of fasting and prayer for those, who through serious sin, had been excluded from Communion and were doing public penance for those sins, so that they could be re-admitted to Communion at Easter. Naturally enough, it became a time of spiritual renewal for all the Faithful – inspired by the conversion of the catechumens and the 're-conversion' of the excommunicated. The whole Church came to adapt Lent as a 'penitential season', whereby all of the Faithful imitated the catechumens, in their desire for full-participation and inclusion, and the penitents, in their sorrow for the choosing of sin, and their 'reconciliation' with God and the Church.




Doors open at 4:00 PM and we will serve until 7:00 PM every Friday until the 22<sup>nd</sup> of March.





- 8) **Tune out** Turn off the television and spend quality time talking with family members or friends.
- 9) Clean out closets Donate gently used items to the St. Vincent de Paul Society.
- 10)**Donate** Pick a Catholic mission and decide how you can help by sending money, clothing or supplies.
