





CATHOLIC CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "What is the 'Roman Martyrology'?"

The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What does the abbreviation 'I H S' stand for? 'I H S' is an abbreviation formed from the first three Greek letters (*lota, Eta, Sigma*) of the name of JESUS. (The letter "J" in English is written with the Latin letter "I".) In Latin, the 'I H S' has also been used as an anagram for: "*IESUS, Hominum Salvator*": 'JESUS of Humanity, Saviour." In use since the 7<sup>th</sup> century, this 'monogram' of the Holy Name of JESUS may often be found in manuscripts and artwork, on statues and church architecture! The Franciscan

Missionary St. Bernardine of Siena (1380-1444) did much to spread devotion to the Holy Name and the Sacred Monogram. The City of *San Bernardino* is named for him!





## Bookkeeper update:

We are at the end of calendar year 2022, which is halfway through our fiscal year. Because of your continuing loyalty to our Parish and our programs, we find ourselves in a good financial position for the time being; however, the trend for this first six months of our fiscal year is an overall decline in contributions. We are 6 percent below where we should be at this time of year.

The reasons are no surprise – ALL of us are daily faced with increasing costs for everything. Within a few weeks, we will be structuring our budget for the next fiscal year. However, if our current trend continues, we will have to consider reducing some of the Parish services. 
