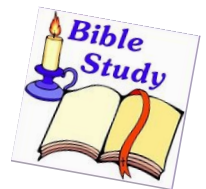

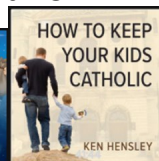

## DID YOU KNOW.....

that we are an “extra mile” Parish?

In the *Gospel of Matthew*, our Lord tells His disciples, “If anyone compels you to go with them a mile, go with them the extra mile.” This willingness, to go the “extra mile”, characterizes our Parish, as we have seen so many times, in your generous response to various needs and challenges, both locally, in our Diocese, and in the global Church!

Your response to our *Annual Catholic Appeal* is a perfect example of this “extra mile” generosity! Although we are very close to making our Parish Goal of \$134,000, we want to

go the “extra mile”, as we have every year of the *Appeal*. For example, last year – a very difficult year for everyone, with the lockdowns, job cutbacks, extra expenses, etc. – our Parish contributed 185% of our Goal – almost doubling our contribution!

This “extra mile” giving is extremely important to our whole Diocesan Church, because we make up any shortfalls for the poorer parishes in our Diocese, making certain that the 25 shared ministries/apostolates are fully funded. (Including, of course, Seminarian education – for our future Priests.)

IF you have not yet made your gift to this year’s *Annual Catholic Appeal*, please consider going the “extra mile” with your fellow parishioners, with a gift of any amount! Our Diocese is counting on all of us!

Some years ago, one of our parishioners was present at a Diocesan meeting, and the remark was made that “St. Andrew’s/Good Shepherd” is a wealthy parish.” The Bishop interrupted and said, “No, they are not a ‘wealthy’ parish; but they are an extremely generous parish.”


That is why we are known as an “extra mile” Parish!

Remember that our *Parish Penance Service* will be on Monday the 28<sup>th</sup>, from 5:00 – 8:00 PM.

The past two years, we have moved to this more ‘open’ celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, as this earlier time seems to work very well, for parishioners who do not like to drive at night, families with school-age children, and people ‘commuting home’ from work. Hopefully, this earlier – and extended -- time will be more convenient for more of our parishioners!

The Penance Service at *Our Lady of the Mountains*, for those who would like another option, will be this coming Thursday, 31 March – from 5:30 – 7:00PM. There will be additional Priest/Confessors at both of these Penance Services.

Please plan on making Confession part of your personal reparation for Holy Week and Easter!

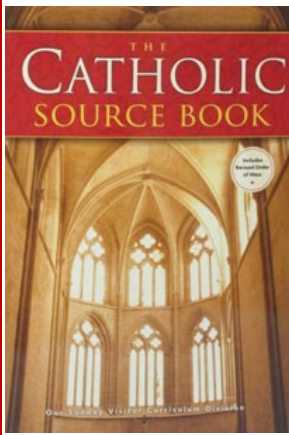

The Answer to last week's Question: *"What does the 'I.N.R.I.' inscription on the crucifix stand for?"* The letters are an anagram of the *Latin* inscription ordered by Pilate to be placed on the Cross (*John 19:19-20*). The 'notice' was written in Hebrew, Greek, and Latin, according to the Gospel. The letter "J" is not in the Greek or Latin alphabet, and the letter "I" is used instead – and so the anagram reads: *Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudaeorum*: 'JESUS (of) Nazareth, King (of the) Jews.'

St. Joseph holds a special place in the life of St. Teresa of Avila, and therefore of the entire Discalced Carmelite Order. Envisioning him as a younger man than was customary in her day, she honored him as the guardian and protector of his Spouse, the Blessed Virgin Mary, who is the guiding light of the Carmelite Order, and of his Foster Son, Jesus Christ. Choosing him as the patron of the first monastery she founded as she began the reform of the Carmelite Order in 1562, Teresa called him "my glorious father St. Joseph" and later said "I have not known anyone truly devoted to St. Joseph and rendering him special services who has not advanced more in virtue." Through the foundation of St. Joseph's in

Avila, Teresa inaugurated a new, more contemplative way of living, reminding all of us to seek resolutely thorough prayer to live by the love that is of God. The Church celebrated the Feast of St. Joseph on March 19<sup>th</sup>.

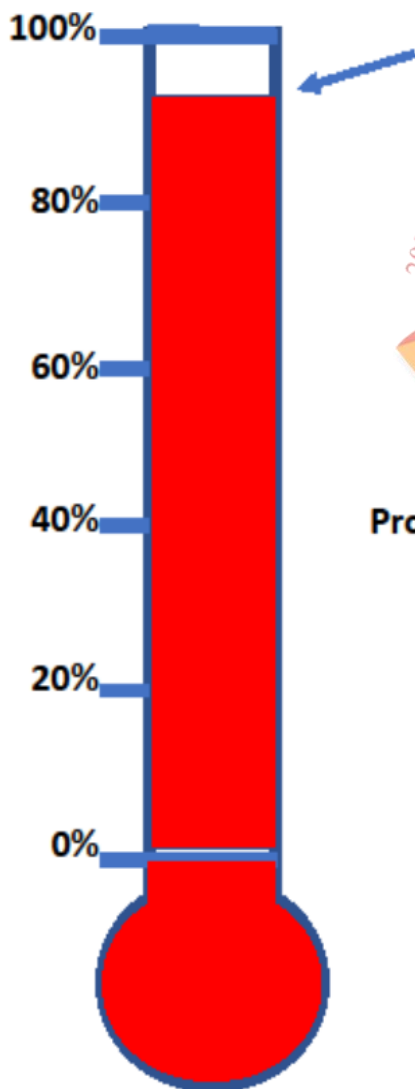

"He refused to enter the house."

—Luke 15:28

We all like to think of ourselves as the younger prodigal son who was warmly welcomed into the Father's embrace. Sometimes, however, we are the older son who bitterly stands outside and refuses to go in. Or we only go into the feast begrudgingly—complaining about new procedures, policies or personalities that we do not like. Whenever we are too busy being bitter, we miss the invitation to "taste and see the goodness of the Lord" (Ps 34:9). Holding onto bitterness about anything only causes our own unhappiness. The people at the party for the younger son were having a great time. The son who stayed outside was the one who was miserable.

#### **How can we fast this week?**

Fast from all bitterness toward anyone—family, friends, strangers or the Church. Let us open our hearts and minds to accept the differences in all our brothers and sisters, realizing that God loves them all as he loves the prodigal son.

#### **How can we pray this week?**

Let us pray for those who are missing the feast for any reason. Those who are grieving, lonely, sick, suffering from addictions, or just angry at God. Pick a few people like this and pray for them by name each day. Or pray in general for all those who are too angry to come to Our Lord's great feast.

#### **How can we give this week?**

Give forgiveness and acceptance to those who have been alienated from us for any reason. Send a note or a card. Reach out with a phone call or a text. Wash away the bitterness and enjoy a new peace.

Linda K. called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and Fr. Greg led the group in an opening prayer. Minutes from the February 2022 meeting were approved as written.

**Finance** (Kate): Income for February was \$83,215 of which \$1,318 were designated to Good Shepherd Mission. Expenses were \$78,965. The Parish general fund level is \$524,461. The Building Our Church fund balance is \$86,087.

**Organ Repair/Upgrade Presentation** (Michelle and Rebecca): The Council reviewed the history of the Church Pipe Organ, the current condition, and repair needs. After discussion, the Council m/s/c to ask the Board of Directors to approve the bid from Grahame Davis for \$65,420 for the repair/upgrade of the organ. \$11,000 will be paid from the current Organ Maintenance Fund, the remainder from the Building Fund. Future donations toward this project will be paid back into the Building Fund.

**Annual Catholic Appeal** (Ann): As of March 18<sup>th</sup>, the Parish has reached 93% of the financial goal, and 57% of the Parish participation goal.

**St. Vincent de Paul Society** (Pauline): Demand for food has increased. Fry's supermarket is generous with the food bank and helping Stan Garner stretch food donation dollars. 824 food boxes were distributed in February serving nearly 1,500 individuals. Thrift Store sales were \$40,900 in February.

**Our Lady of the Sierras** (Charlie): A new Managing Director, Monica Garcia, will be starting in July. Bebe Benites will work with her on a reduced hour schedule until her retirement later this year. The St. Andrew Confirmation retreat was a big success. Retreat schedules are filling up. Fr. Marco will be leading Stations of the Cross on Good Friday this year.

**Hispanic Ministry** (Lupita): Fr. Marco contacted Lupita asking for prayers for a priest in our sponsored Parish in Veracruz, Mexico, who will be undergoing surgery for a foot injury.

**Ladies of St. Andrew** (Fran): The Ladies have resumed regular monthly meetings. The "Baby Shower for Baby Jesus" will be held in May and items collected will be distributed through Care Net Pregnancy Center.

**Knights of Columbus and St. Paul Street Evangelization** (Ed): Grand Knight Ed reports that the Lenten Fish Fry dinners on Friday night have been well attended. Ed continues his evangelization activities throughout the community and working with the Knights has allowed him to expand contacts.

**Scholarships** (Thad): Two scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors in the Community. The deadline for application is May 16<sup>th</sup>.

**Building and Grounds** (Maryann): The Forgach House parking lot lights have been upgraded and Catholic Community Services acknowledged the work our staff did with a thank you letter. Old West Cleaning cleaned the pews, chairs and kneelers in the Church. We have renewed the license for the commercial kitchen. The Committee started to look at suggestions for the 2023 Capital Budget.

**Pastor's Report** (Fr Greg): Fr. Greg received a letter from the Parish in Veracruz, Mexico acknowledging and thanking us for our donation of \$5,000. The Diocese will join in the Consecration of Russia to the Blessed Virgin on Friday the 25<sup>th</sup>. Special prayers will be offered at both Masses on Friday. The Catholic Relief Services collection on May 27<sup>th</sup> is designated for the Ukraine and refugees in Poland. On Saturday April 23<sup>rd</sup>, Sacred Heart Parish in Tombstone will celebrate its 141<sup>st</sup> anniversary, 75<sup>th</sup> in the present Church. The event is being advertised as a Fiesta of Faith, also being promoted as "Heaven Dorada Days". Bishop Weisenburger will preside at Mass to start the day's festivities. A new Chaplain is in place at the Bisbee jail, and we hope to resume ministry in April. The Easter sunrise service will be at 6:00 a.m. on Easter Sunday at Veteran's Memorial Park. Linda adjourned the meeting at 6:50 p.m., Fr. Greg led the group in a closing prayer, and Fr. Ramonito blessed the group.
