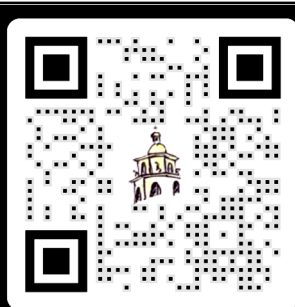

DID YOU KNOW....

that to begin the new year of grace, 2024, our Parish will celebrate a Consecration to the Holy Family?

As we begin the new year, we are reminded that we have not been created and redeemed by our God so that we could somehow “get through life”. We have been called and equipped so that “life can get through us”!

In this New Year, we can respond to the Lord’s call and recommit ourselves to restoring family values throughout our community and our own homes by first consecrating ourselves to the Holy Family!

And so, next Sunday, 31 December, parishioners will be invited to recite the “Consecration to the Holy Family Prayer” together as a parish family at all weekend Masses. The Holy Family Prayer Cards can be found in all pews and you are invited to take a prayer card with you and perhaps take the following actions:

As a family pray together each day following the Consecration. This will help our families to continue to pray and be renewed as ‘holy families’!

The old adage “The family that prays together, stays together!” is based in reality. Spiritual life is fed and supported by prayer. To gather together as a family to pray the Rosary, to pray the Consecration Prayer, to pray for the special needs and intentions of family members (and others) opens our lives to infinite and eternal possibilities, AND welcomes the Holy Spirit to flow into and through our lives! This is ‘Life getting through us’!!

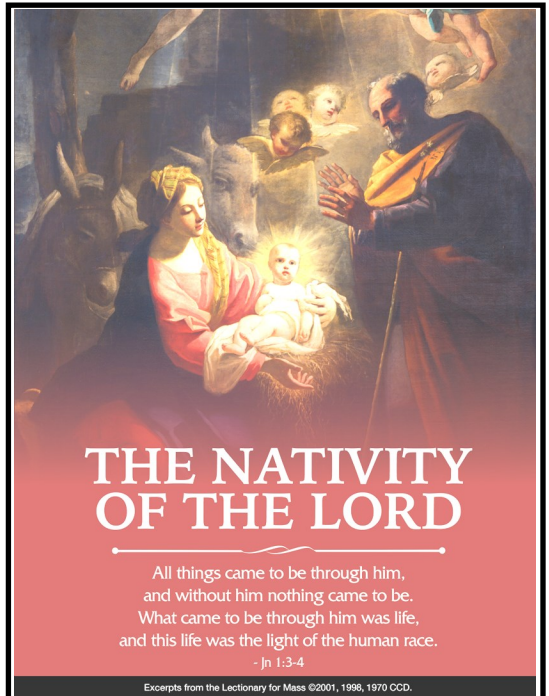
Consider fasting at least one day each week - fast from something that would normally be consumed or an activity that is regularly done. Fasting helps to discipline our minds and hearts and moves us to be more focused on God!

A reminder, that the ‘Friday fast’ has never been abolished by the Church but remains a powerful way to stay mindful of the Sacrifice of Christ every Friday, not just during Lent!

AND, please consider coming to Confession, as part of your on-going Consecration. Frequent reception of this Sacrament not only ‘erases sin’ but strengthens our desire to seek and to do God’s Will! Frequent Confession holds us to a higher accountability for our own spiritual growth.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated every weekday, one half hour before the 9:00 AM and 12:05 Noon Masses, on Saturday at 8:30 AM and from 3:30-5:00 PM, on Sundays from 7:30 to 8:00 AM, and 4:00-5:00PM – and anytime by appointment, or by simply asking one of the Priests to hear your Confession! There are many opportunities to celebrate this Sacrament, and to do so as a family is a special opportunity to strengthen the bonds of Faith!

We are very grateful to the Knights of Columbus, our *Bishop Salpointe Council #4584* for providing the Consecration Prayer cards and for sponsoring this graced opportunity for our whole Parish – no matter what the size or makeup of your family!

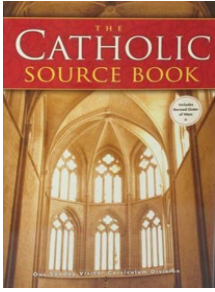

CATHOLIC QUIZ: *This week's Question: "Where did the custom of Christmas candles in windows come from?"*



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "When and at what time was Christ born?"

Originally, Christ's birth was celebrated as part of the Feast of Epiphany, which 'bundled' the Nativity, the Epiphany, the Baptism, and first Miracle of Christ (at Cana). The last three are still celebrated together in the Eastern Orthodox Churches. Around the year 330, however, the Church in Rome assigned the celebration of Christ's birth to December 25. Church scholars contend that the date was chosen to counteract the pagan festival of the "Invincible Sun" – connected with the Winter Solstice. A very early tradition – from the Syriac Church – is that JESUS was born on the 14th day of the Jewish month of Nisan – the very same day that He died on the Cross. However the traditional dating evolved, the date of 25 December is now universally observed in all Christian Churches. The tradition 'time' of the Lord's birth – midnight - is deduced from a passage in the Apocrypha: *'when half spent was the night, the Mighty Word leaped down from His throne.'*
