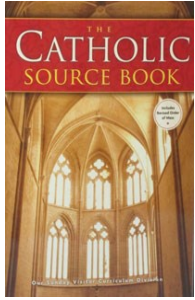

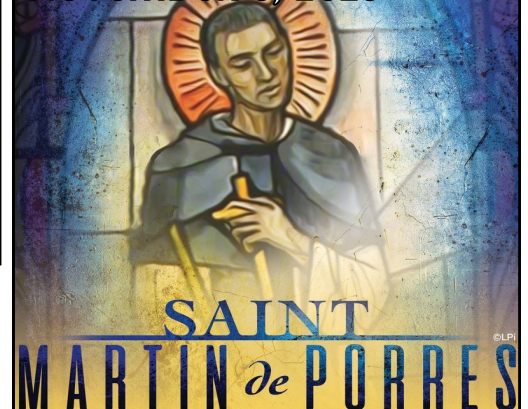
### Call 911
