

DID YOU KNOW....

that there is a <u>cost</u> to being a disciple of JESUS Christ? Many of us living in comfortable and affluent societies seem to assume that being a Christian does not require any serious sacrifice or even discomfort.

The Nigerian Priests serving among us, *Fr. Samuel* and *Fr. Jude*, bring us a sometimes not gentle reminder of the real situation for many, if not most, Catholics in the world today. There is certainly a real undercurrent of anti-Catholicism in our own country, which has been there since the beginning of European settlement, mixed with later anti-immigrant and racist views. But the reality of open persecution is not something that most Americans have had to experience.

We celebrate the love of God with the universal symbol of the Cross, so it is strange that those who claim to be followers of JESUS rarely consider the true "cost of discipleship," as the Lutheran theologian and martyr (1945) *Dietrick Bonhoeffer* put it. Instead, many opt for what Bonhoeffer referred to as "cheap grace," a kind of 'Christianity-lite' that aligns comfortably with the surrounding culture and with our own interests and priorities.


The late Catholic theologian *Fr. Virgil Elizando* spoke of the subtle undermining of the Faith in developed First World countries, (like the U.S.) by what he called the 'three C's': Comfort, Compromise, Complacency. *Fr. Virgil* said that if Comfort is our highest priority and value (and much of what we call 'security' is actually an addiction to Comfort), then we will begin making serious moral Compromises ("I don't want to make anyone uncomfortable – (or myself!) – by standing up for the Truth and for the values of the Catholic Faith.") When there is this kind of Compromise, then inevitably we become Complacent about the Truth, about the Gospel and its demands! Truth-Beauty-Goodness – the triad of Absolutes because they have their Source in God, become "relative" ("My truth is not necessarily someone else's truth." "Perhaps those people had their own reasons for slavery. . . or the Holocaust. . . or promoting abortion. . ")

This form of persecution, subtly eroding the foundations, rather than openly attacking the Church, can be clearly seen in every sector of life – including relentless attacks on the basic building block of society: the family.

It is a good time to reevaluate our own Christian commitments. When confronted with evil or injustice, do we ask "What would JESUS have me do?" Or "What does the Church teach me about this issue?" Or do we prefer to not 'rock the boat' or place ourselves in an un-Comfortable position, so as to avoid the opposition, hatred, and persecution which JESUS says will come to His disciples, to His Church?

What are we willing to do or give or give up in order to be authentic disciples of Christ?

How we answer that kind of question reveals a lot about our priorities for life and what kind of Christians we are. This weekend we have the icon of "Our Lady, Help of the Persecuted" present in the church, courtesy of the *Knights of Columbus*! Prayer/Intercession cards are also available for your use!



CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "What is the Exaltation of the Holy Cross?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What about JESUS' 'brothers and sisters' mentioned in the Bible?" The Scriptures are explicit: 'How can this be, since I am a virgin?' In both Aramaic (the language spoken in Palestine) and the Hebrew of the Old Testament, 'brothers' means close relatives, such as 'cousins', for which there is no word in Aramaic or Hebrew. The phrase 'brothers of the Lord' does not refer to other children of Mary (see: Mark 3:31-35; 6:3; 1 Corinthians 9:5; Galatians 1:19). James and Joseph, 'brothers of JESUS,' are, in fact, sons of another Mary, who was a disciple of the Lord (Matthew 13:55, 28:1; Matthew 27:56). The early and consistent belief of the Church was, and is, that Mary was a virgin at the time of JESUS' conception, and remained in the virginal state throughout her life, and, thus, had no other 'offspring'. The Eastern Orthodox Church, likewise proclaiming the 'perpetual

virginity' of Mary, has offered an ancient tradition that the 'brethren of the Lord' were the children of Joseph by his first marriage, and thus, were not 'blood-relatives' of Mary or, of course, JESUS.






