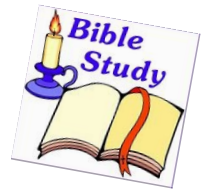

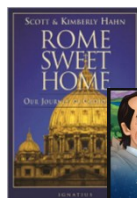

## DID YOU KNOW.....

that 'Spring housecleaning' actually has its origins in the Jewish practice of ritually cleansing one's house before the celebration of Passover?

The season of Lent very much invites us to 'take stock, pare down and simplify our lives'.

*Richard Foster*, in his book *A Celebration of Discipline*, offers ten very practical – but challenging -- guidelines for living lives of "abundant simplicity" and which address the inevitable 'clutter' in our lives resulting from living in a consumer society:

- 1) Buy things for the actual usefulness rather than pride of ownership – what is essential rather than what is desirable.
- 2) Reject anything that invites addictive behavior: be it coffee, cigarettes, television, computer games, 'surfing the net'.
- 3) Develop the habit of giving things away, especially if they are not being used regularly.
- 4) Refuse to be seduced by the promotion of gadgets, 'time saving' devices, or entertainment products.
- 5) Stop trying to fill the voids in our lives with things. The best things in life are not things.
- 6) Develop a deeper appreciation for God's creation. For example, take walks, listen to the birds, enjoy the night sky.
- 7) Buy only what we need and what we can afford to pay for now.
- 8) Make honesty and integrity the distinguishing characteristics of our speech and our life.
- 9) Reject anything that contributes to the oppression of others. For example, know from where products come and how they are produced.
- 10) Shun whatever would distract us from attaining the reason for which we were created. (*"To know God, to love God, to serve God, and to be happy with God forever!" – The Baltimore Catechism*).

*Pope St. Paul VI* observed that "We need to learn to live more simply, so that others can simply live." Lent is a God-given time, a seven week 'sabbatical', to do some serious "Spring housecleaning" in our lives!

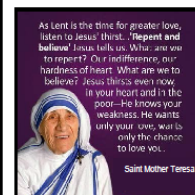

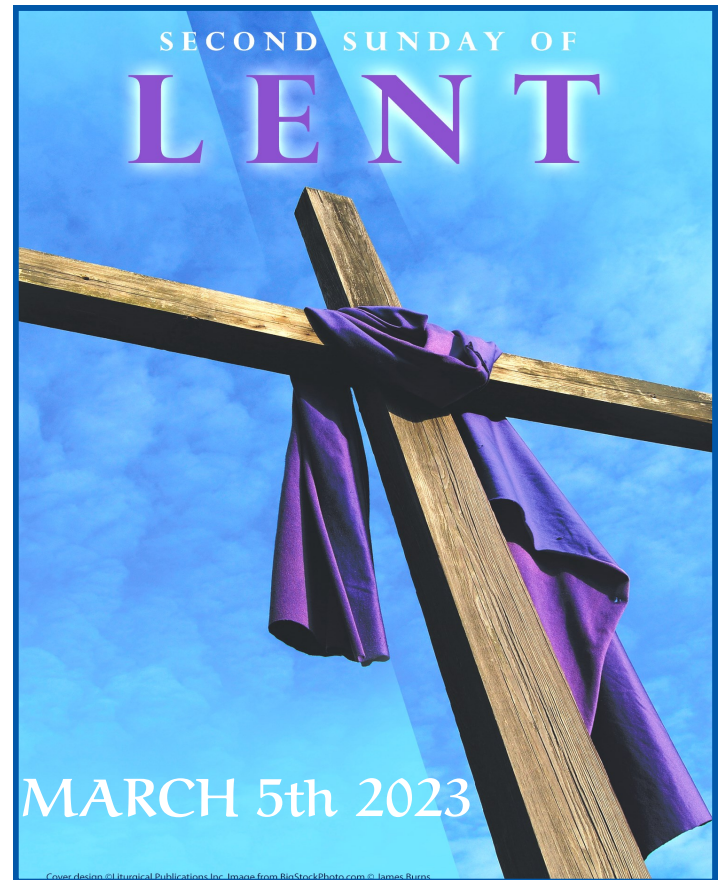

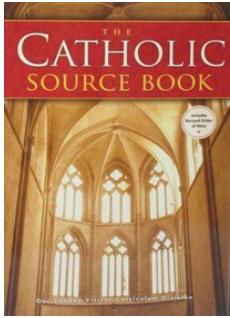

## Second Sunday of Lent-March 5, 2023

**CATHOLIC QUIZ:** *This week's Question: "Can Baptisms take place in Lent?"*



*The Answer to Last Week's Question: "Why the Lenten fast from meat on Fridays?"*

In the Gospel of Mark (2:18-20), we read: "...Some people came to JESUS and asked Him, "Why is it that the disciples of John the Baptist and the disciples of the Pharisees fast, but your disciples do not?" JESUS answered, "Do you expect the guests at a wedding to fast while the Bridegroom is with them? But the day will come when the Bridegroom will be taken away from them, and then they will fast." Because JESUS, the Bridegroom, was 'taken away' on Good Friday, that day became for the earliest Christians, a day of Fasting and abstaining from meat/blood. By extension, over time, the Good Friday Fast was observed on all Fridays, as a solemn remembrance of the Bridegroom's self-offering for the life of the Bride: the Church. In the liturgical reforms of the Church, following the Second Vatican Council, the Church asked the Faithful to choose our own particular form of fasting and abstinence on Fridays, (trusting far too much in the spiritual maturity of the Faithful!), and kept the mandatory fast/abstinence from meat for the Fridays in Lent. (Please note, that Friday Fast – for all Fridays – was never 'abolished' by the Church. That is a popular and totally mistaken notion by those who decided that the voluntary abstinence from meat meant no fast need be observed on Fridays!)

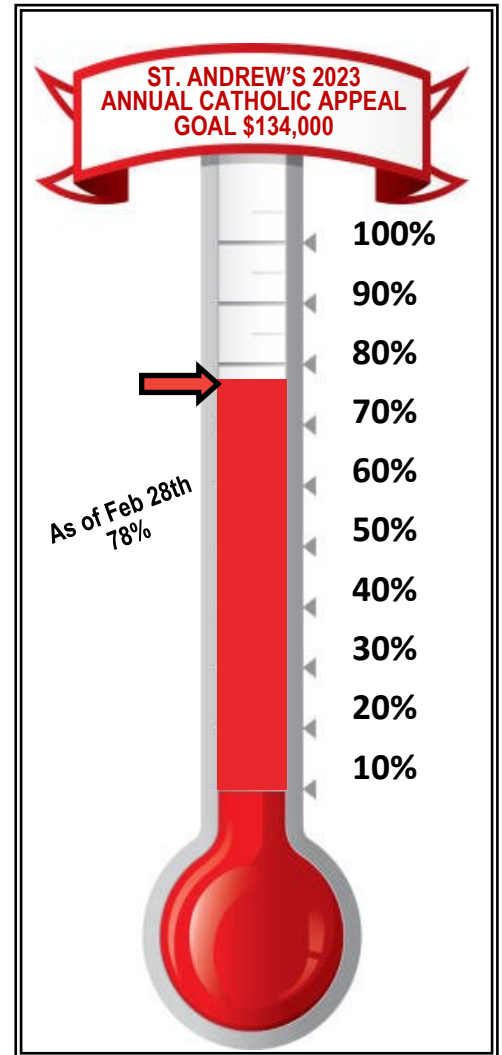

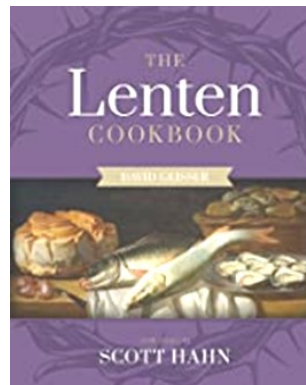

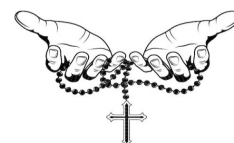

## REFLECT

On March 25, 2020, the Church celebrated the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the papal encyclical *Evangelium vitae* (*The Gospel of Life*). This prophetic document, written by Pope St. John Paul II, reaffirmed the Church's constant teaching on the value and inviolability of every human life.

*The Gospel of Life* highlights the special and particular role of women in bearing the gift of life. St. John Paul II offers heartfelt thanks to "heroic mothers," who, placing their trust in God, "devote themselves to their own family without reserve, who suffer in giving birth to their children and who are ready to make any effort, to face any sacrifice, in order to pass on to them the best of themselves" (EV 86). The Holy Father also outlines many challenges that expectant mothers may face, recognizing that an "unborn child is totally entrusted to the protection and care of the woman carrying him or her in the womb" (EV 58). For this reason, it is particularly important that the Church come alongside mothers, offering encouragement, assistance, and support that is life-affirming for both them and their children.
