Singers from a number of local churches form a 'master choir' and we are all invited to sing along with them, to marvelous accompaniment!

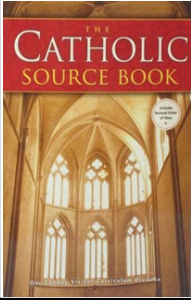

CATHOLIC QUIZ: *This week's Question: "What does the abbreviation 'A-M-R' stand for?"*



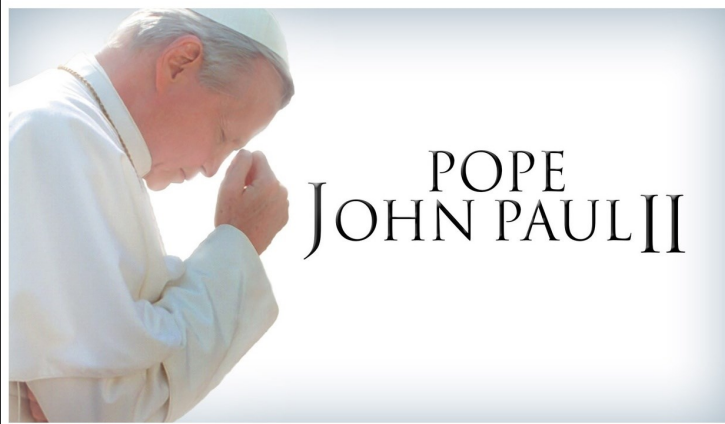
The Answer to Last Week's Question: "What does the abbreviation 'XP' stand for as a Christian symbol?" The capitalized Greek letters *chi* and *rho* are equivalent to CH and R in Latin or English. It is the monogram for CHrist, consisting of the first two Greek letters of that title. Hence called the *Chi-Rho* ("Kai Row"). This Greek abbreviation or monogram also explains the origin of 'X-mas,' – the Mass of Christ -- another expression of the *XP = Chi-Rho*!
