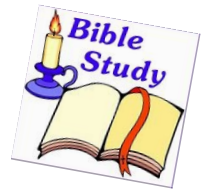

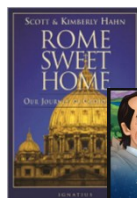

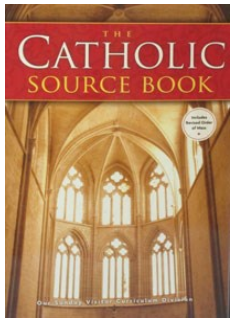

The Answer to Last Week's Question: "Can Baptisms take place in Lent?"



Normally, baptisms are not celebrated in Lent, but rather are delayed until the Easter Season.

If there is sufficient reason, however, such as illness of the child, or other circumstances, then Baptism may be celebrated, even in Lent. (Because we are in a military community, where sometimes travel needs make the delay of Baptism difficult – and we would now extend that to the travel needs of godparents, who unlike the 'old days' very often live a great distances – the celebration of Baptism can take place in Lent, in light of 'special circumstances.') However, the 'normal practice' is to wait until Lent is over, and celebrate Baptism in the Easter Season!

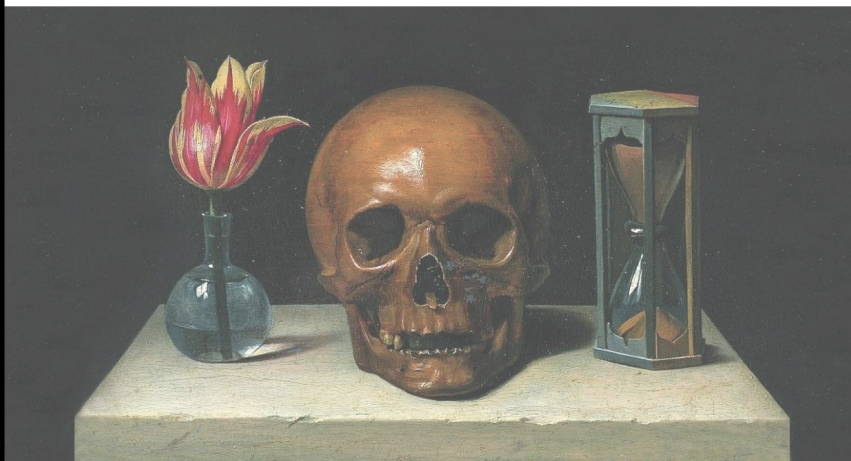

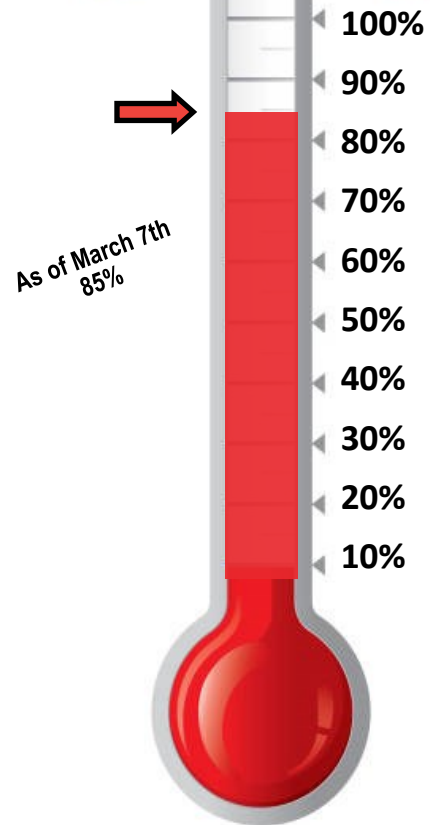

REFLECT

On March 25, 2020, the Church celebrated the 25th anniversary of the papal encyclical *Evangelium vitae* (*The Gospel of Life*). This prophetic document, written by Pope St. John Paul II, reaffirmed the Church's constant teaching on the value and inviolability of every human life.

The Gospel of Life highlights the special and particular role of women in bearing the gift of life. St. John Paul II offers heartfelt thanks to "heroic mothers," who, placing their trust in God, "devote themselves to their own family without reserve, who suffer in giving birth to their children and who are ready to make any effort, to face any sacrifice, in order to pass on to them the best of themselves" (EV 86). The Holy Father also outlines many challenges that expectant mothers may face, recognizing that an "unborn child is totally entrusted to the protection and care of the woman carrying him or her in the womb" (EV 58). For this reason, it is particularly important that the Church come alongside mothers, offering encouragement, assistance, and support that is life-affirming for both them and their children.

- Read the reflection, "He Made His Dwelling Among Us: The Annunciation and *The Gospel of Life*," (www.bit.ly/ev-annunciation) and spend time prayerfully reflecting on the gift of human life.
- Choose a day this week to fast for the featured intention.
- Offer some other sacrifice, prayer, or act of penance that you feel called to do for the featured intention.
