



DID YOU KNOW.....

that we have some good news to share?

First, from *Bishop Weisenburger*: "As of the end of April, the Diocese of Tucson had received \$190,243 for Ukraine relief. \$95,117 was sent to CNEWA (*Catholic Near East Welfare Association*) and \$95,117 was sent to the *Church in Central & Eastern Europe*. Both donations were designated for Ukraine Relief. May these donations assist those in need and may God restore peace to the people of Ukraine! Please thank all of your Parishioners!" (*St. Andrew's/Good Shepherd* parishioners contributed \$20,000 to the Diocese Collection for Ukraine Relief!)

More good news: You may have noticed some changes in the North Parking lot. In 1997, when the "new" Parish Office was built and *Madonna Hall* expanded to its present configuration, the median in the North parking lot was designated as the "*Knights' Way*" as a memorial to deceased members of the *Knights of Columbus*, *Bishop Salpointe Council*, and featured a large *Knights of Columbus* logo, surrounded by bricks inscribed with the names of deceased Knights.

The growth of the Parish and a lot more 'traffic' meant that this Memorial was simply becoming a walkway. The decision was made to relocate the "*Knights' Way Memorial*" to the placita in front of *Madonna Hall*, to a shaded area near the *Knights' Pro-Life* plaque. The logo and the memorial bricks will be installed in this area in the coming weeks, and a dedication of the area will be scheduled!

More good news: We are very grateful for the volunteer landscapers, who are often found trimming, watering, pruning, and generally helping our Maintenance Staff to care for our two-campus Parish grounds, and making certain that our neighbors enjoy our campuses, as well as our Parishioners! This is especially important in the summer months, when extra care is needed to keep everything looking its best!

More good news: We received a very, very generous bequest from the Estate of Parishioner, *Tom Kennedy*! The bequest was designated to the General Fund AND the Building Fund. The timing is Providential, as we are preparing to install new H/AC in *Kino Hall* this summer, to replace the dated and faltering systems!

IF you have not considered a bequest to our Parish in your Estate planning, would you prayerfully do so? Over the years, such bequests have made an enormous difference in keeping our Parish financially healthy, and, provided needed funds for "large ticket" projects (such as our Convent) without having to engage in a Capital Campaign. Please consider making your loving support for our Parish a continuing legacy after your death — *Tom Kennedy* did, and it makes a huge difference!




ATTENTION ALL CRAFTERS and TALENTED ARTISANS!




