





CATHOLIC QUIZ: This week's Question: "What is the 'legend of the Pelican' in connection with the Eucharist?"



The answer to last week's Question: "What is 'St. John's Wort'?" The little wildflowers known as St. John's Wort (a herb: hypericum perforatum) – are full of legend! Appearing around the Feast of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist (24 June) – six months before Christmas Eve, it is said that these little flowers first opened on St. John's Feast, when daylight is triumphant over night (the longest day of the year), proclaiming, as John himself did, the advent of Christ, the Light of the world! Among the legends attached to this wildflower; according to English lore, it will stop a witch in her tracks; it will give protection from evil spirits, when, according to German tradition, a wreath of it is placed on the housetop;

according to the Swedes and Norwegians, it will ward off evil when hung in the house; when dipped in olive oil and preserved, it is a balm for wounds, according to Sicilian legend; it will neutralize hydrophobia, according to Russian belief; and dew from the flower rubbed on the eyes will preserve the health of the eyes. . .AND, today, it is used as naturopathic help for those suffering from depression! Many flowers and herbs have 'accumulated' Christian meaning and symbolism over the centuries. There are many flowers which have been attached to the Blessed Virgin Mary (marigolds, for example)! Happy Feast of St. John the Baptist this coming Thursday!






