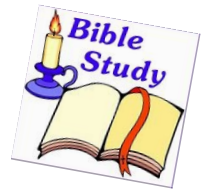

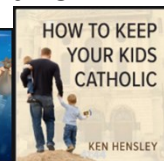

DID YOU KNOW.....

that among the other ‘casualties’ of the pandemic is the incredible falling-off of volunteerism (or as we call it in the Church: “active discipleship”) across our whole society?

Social scientists have spoken about the unintended consequences of social distancing (isolation) and the impact on normal social networking.

They have described this as the ‘second wave of the pandemic’. In almost every area of community life – service clubs, social services, school tutoring, and, yes, parish life – there has been a huge decline in the number of people offering their services as volunteers. There are many reasons given for this: the lack of demand for volunteer services during the two-year period of the pandemic with the closing or curtailment of activities of so many organizations, fear of contagion (contact), shrinking of social circles to immediate family, the deadly sin of Sloth, etc.

Again and again, we have talked about the absolute necessity for the People of God to offer (volunteer) their time, their skills and abilities, as well as their resources, if the Church is to fulfill her mission! We cannot continue to be an active, growing, Parish without volunteers – active, engaged disciples -- and that is a very simple matter of fact.

It is not just our *Good Shepherd Mission* which needs active disciples to serve as Lectors, Musicians, Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, Sacristans, Ministers of Hospitality, *St. Andrew’s* is so needful for folks to serve in these Ministries that we are seriously overworking the few who are presently serving. There are three very notable exceptions: our *Knights of Columbus*, our *St. Vincent de Paul Society and Food Bank*, and our weekend Ministers of Hospitality – although they too are looking for others to serve alongside them! Yes, the required Diocesan Safe Environment clearance process for volunteers has to be adhered to in order to maintain our liability insurance coverage, and yes, it is a bit of a nuisance, but *Lupita Teran* our Compliance Manager, has made the process about as pain-free as possible! Please don’t make this the reason that you ‘bury your talents’ (Matthew 25:24-26). There is an old hymn, which makes the case in one verse: “*Rise up, O Men [and Women] of God, the Church for you doth wait; her strength unequal to her task, rise up and make her great!*” Please don’t let our Parish and your personal discipleship become victims of the pandemic!

A HUGE thank you to all of those who stepped up to make our 33rd Annual Catholic Appeal Dinner such a success! Thank you to our *Knights of Columbus* for this tremendous gift to our Parish, to the *Teran Family*, to our *ACA Committee*, to our *Life Teens*, to the women of our *Parish Staff*, to the set-up and clean-up crews, to our DJ, *Robert Benton*, to the young Officers from the “Captains’ Course” on Post, and to all of the VOLUNTEERS without whom none of this could happen!

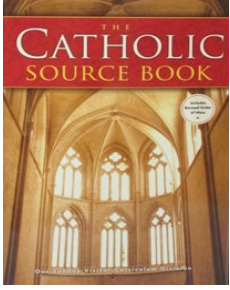

The answer to last week's Question – "What is an 'Oblation'?"

Oblation, meaning "the act of offering; an instance of offering" and by extension "the thing offered", is a term used, particularly in the Sacred Liturgy, for a solemn offering, sacrifice or presentation to God, (*"receive this oblation, O Lord, we pray"*) or to the Church for use in God's service, or to the faithful, such as giving alms to the poor. You may be familiar with a Mexican treat – a wafer cookie – called an *"oblea"*, which takes its name from the oblation (host) offered at Mass!

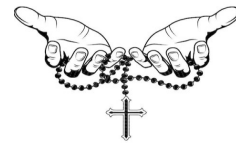

REFLECT

In *Evangelium vitae (The Gospel of Life)*, Pope John Paul II applauds the daily heroism of mothers who selflessly devote themselves to their children. This modern-day saint also highlights the unfortunate reality that “these heroic women do not always find support in the world around them.” He goes on to say, “On the contrary, the cultural models frequently promoted and broadcast by the media do not encourage motherhood. In the name of progress and modernity the values of fidelity, chastity, sacrifice, to which a host of Christian wives and mothers have borne and continue to bear outstanding witness, are presented as obsolete” (EV 86).

A culture that fails to truly value motherhood naturally becomes hostile to the gift of new life. When the Church compassionately serves mothers, it witnesses to the beauty of human life. There is a great need for real, tangible assistance for expectant mothers. Christ calls us to serve those most alone and in need. In a world that often turns it back on mothers who sacrifice so much of themselves, may we, the Church’s members, rise to help mothers in need of assistance and support.

- Offer some other sacrifice, prayer, or act of penance that you feel called to do for the featured intention.
