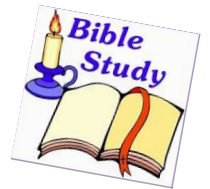

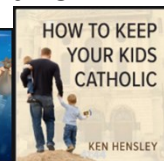

Anointed with Sacred Chrism, those being Confirmed will be strengthened by the Holy Spirit to fulfill their Calling -- as disciples of the Lord!

Unlike Graduation, which marks the end of a person's life as a student, Confirmation marks the beginning -- of a young Christian's life as a maturing adult, personally responding to JESUS' invitation to "Follow ME"!

Those who are being Confirmed will assume a greater role in the life of the Church, all of them as active participants in the worship and service of God's People; some of them as Priests, Deacons and Consecrated Religious Women!

One of the three Sacraments which mark a Believer "indelibly" -- (Baptism and Holy Orders, are the other two), Confirmation "seals" a person with the Power of the Holy Spirit and gives them a 'character' -- impressed upon and fashioned by the Lord. Because of this new 'character' and status, those receiving Confirmation receive a 'new name' -- a Confirmation name, usually that of a Saint, which the person has chosen because of the 'Christian character' of that Saint, which they want to emulate in their own Faith Walk!

The celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation -- is one of the real "high points" in the life of a Parish! Welcoming young believers as adult members and sharers in the life of commitment and service, is a BIG moment in the life of the Family of God!

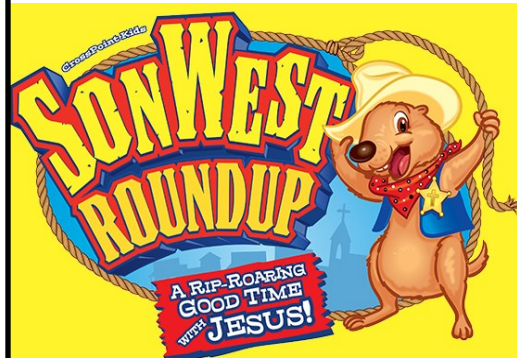

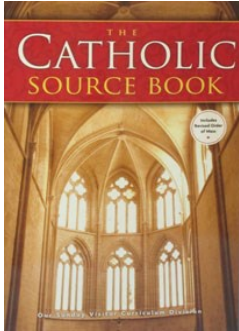

The Answer to Last Week's Question: "Why does the Pope wear a white cassock?" Pope St. Pius V (1504-1572) kept his white Dominican habit (the Dominicans were popularly known as the "White Friars") when he was elected Pope in 1566, instead of the red then worn by Popes and Cardinals, (Cardinals still wear red). When Pope Pius V was canonized for his important work in reforming the Church and the Liturgy – as part of the reforms instituted by the Council of Trent – his choice of wearing the simple, white habit became "papal" and since then, all of the Popes wear a white cassock!

GriefShare is a nationwide biblical support group that is focused on helping people who are dealing with a loved one's death. Each DVD session features nationally respected grief experts and real-life stories, followed by small group discussion about the topics presented (with workbook support). At each GriefShare session you will find encouragement and help in grieving the death of your loved one. No matter the cause of your loved one's death, this is an opportunity to be around people who understand what you are feeling. You will learn how to recognize the symptoms of being stuck in grief and how to cope with the normal emotions that come when grieving a death. You will learn valuable information on facing life situations, and you'll gain renewed hope for the future. These sessions are open to anyone regardless of whether your experience is recent or not so recent. The group is led by individuals who have personally experienced grief due to a loved one's death. Each leader is trained in facilitating a GriefShare support group.

Our GriefShare group will meet every Wednesday, starting May 24th, 2023, 5 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in Madonna Hall, room #3.

We hope you will consider joining us. Please remember your loss is shared by others in this church and what you are experiencing is sometimes easier to bear knowing others are listening and do care. May God's love continue to comfort and strengthen you.

### HAND CARVED in BETHLEHEM

**PLEASE STOP BY THE TABLES OF RELIGIOUS WARES (Nativity set, rosaries, statues, crucifixes, charms, etc.) AFTER ALL THE MASSES THE WEEKEND OF (May 13 & 14).**

Ayman Khair is representing about 180 Christian families from Bethlehem. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East and the Pandemic, tourism has been stopped completely from March 2, 2020 till February 2022 and it is very slow now.

It is very important to support them at this critical time since they have no income and there is no government to take care of them and help them. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United State to purchase their articles.

These **hand carved religious articles are beyond description.** Carved from **wood of the sacred Olive tree**, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income are able to stay and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support.

### St. Andrew the Apostle Parish Monthly Council Meeting April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023, 5:30 p.m.

**In Attendance:** Fr. Greg, Fr Samuel, Fr. Simon, Linda Klein, Ann Dickson, Maryann Hockstad, Charlie Irwin, Dcn Lauro & Lupita Teran, Pauline Fredericks, Linda Denno Chuck Muscato, Mike Wilson, and Kate Callender (recording)

Linda K. called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. and Fr. Greg led the group in an opening prayer. Minutes from the March meeting were approved as written.

**Finance** (Kate): Income for March was \$82,147 of which \$3,870 were designated to Good Shepherd Mission. Expenses were \$111,961. The Parish general fund level is \$524,268. The Building Our Church fund balance is \$87,005.

**All Saints School** (Mike Wilson): There are currently 77 students enrolled for the next school year, with a goal of 100. The school received a \$4,000 donation from Jim Click's dealership in Tucson. Anonymous donors continue to support the school. CTSO deadline is Mid-May.

**Good Shepherd Mission** (Chuck): There are some lighting issues which need to be addressed. Maintenance staff will make those repairs as soon as possible. This month's water bill was much higher than usual. Maintenance will be checking for a possible leak.

**Our Lady of the Sierras Foundation** (Charlie): Very good attendance at Stations of the Cross on Good Friday.

**St Vincent de Paul Society** (Pauline): The Thrift Store had over \$45,000 sales in March. Leah Waller reports that the employees have started morning prayer before the store opens each day. The Conference received a \$20,000 gift from The Good Shepherd fund, a Texas-based charity. Pauline gave a presentation at the Pastors' monthly Breakfast at the hospital on the work of the Conference, which was very well received.

**Building and Grounds** (Maryann): The Committee is still looking for a firm to refurbish and install new screens over the organ pipes. The fence around Kino Hall's A/C unit will be finished in the coming weeks, materials/labor being donated by Parishioners. The Committee is finding it increasingly difficult to find local vendors for work on the campus and may have to solicit bids for projects from surrounding communities.

**Pipe Organ** (Maryann for Michelle): The concert on March 24<sup>th</sup> was well attended and over \$1,000 was donated toward the refurbishment fund. The next concert is scheduled for April 28<sup>th</sup> and one additional one is scheduled for July 7<sup>th</sup>.

**ACA** (Maryann): Total pledges now stand at \$164,677, which is 123% of Parish Goal. The donor count is 332.

**Fr. Simon** reports that the students at All Saints School are pleased to have a priest working with them and helping them with their reconciliations and education in the faith. Fr Simon has also made visits to other ministry organizations including a recent tour of the Food Bank.

**Fr. Samuel** expressed his enjoyment of the Easter liturgies at St. Andrew. The Via Christi Society is having a Chapter Meeting in July, and he will be traveling to Nigeria to participate.

**Pastor Report:** Fr. Greg asked for prayers for Christians in Kenya and Nigeria as persecution continues. An ice-cream social Farewell for Sisters Joellen and Doris will be held on Sunday, June 11<sup>th</sup>. The Fish Fry evenings were a big success throughout Lent. Bishop Weisenburger will confirm 43 young people from St Andrew, 6 from Our Lady of the Mountains and one from St. Patrick's at the Sunday 5 p.m. Mass on April 23<sup>rd</sup>. The clergy Convocation is in Tucson on the 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> of April. Our Religious Volunteers are still being denied access to Bisbee Jail but hope to be allowed in soon. The Knights' sponsored Silver Rose will be here on 30 May. Deacon Bill and Fr Mike Martinez from OLM have a group of young men, a "Seeker's Group" who are exploring the possibility of a vocation. Attendance has been very good at the Lenten/Easter liturgies. Fr Greg expressed gratitude to all the Deacons for their time and generosity, and also praised the Maintenance team for their dedication and ability to complete maintenance projects in a cost-effective manner. Linda adjourned the meeting at 6:38 p.m. Fr. Greg led the group in closing prayer and Fr. Simon imparted his blessing.
