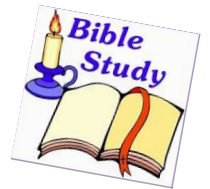

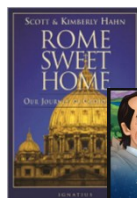

## DID YOU KNOW....

This coming Saturday, 22 April, is the 45<sup>th</sup> Annual "Blessing of the Vines" at the Sonoita Vineyards? Dr. Gordon Dutt, a retired U of A soil scientist, established this first commercial vineyard in southern Arizona in 1975, and beginning in 1978 invited local clergy to celebrate a Blessing of the vineyard each Spring. The Sonoita Vineyard has provided the altar wine used here at St. Andrew's/Good Shepherd for many years. (Our Communion hosts are made by the Trappistine Sisters at Santa Rita Abbey, just north of Sonoita!) The Blessing of the Vines takes place at Noon, and the day includes tastings, tours of the winery and vineyard and a Procession through the vineyards! There are local food vendors providing good things to eat, and many people pack a picnic lunch to enjoy on the grounds! To reach the Sonoita Vineyards, go west on Hwy 82 (the road to Nogales) to Upper Elgin Road, turn left, on Upper Elgin Road go 5 miles south – as you enter Elgin, you go over a one-lane bridge, make a quick left turn onto the paved Elgin-Canelo Road. Travel 3 miles south on Elgin-Canelo Road, take a right onto the road that leads up to the large building – the Winery on the hill! 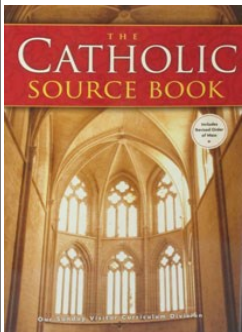

This has become one of the most popular of the 'new' Feasts – and carries the Message of Mercy into the whole Easter Season!

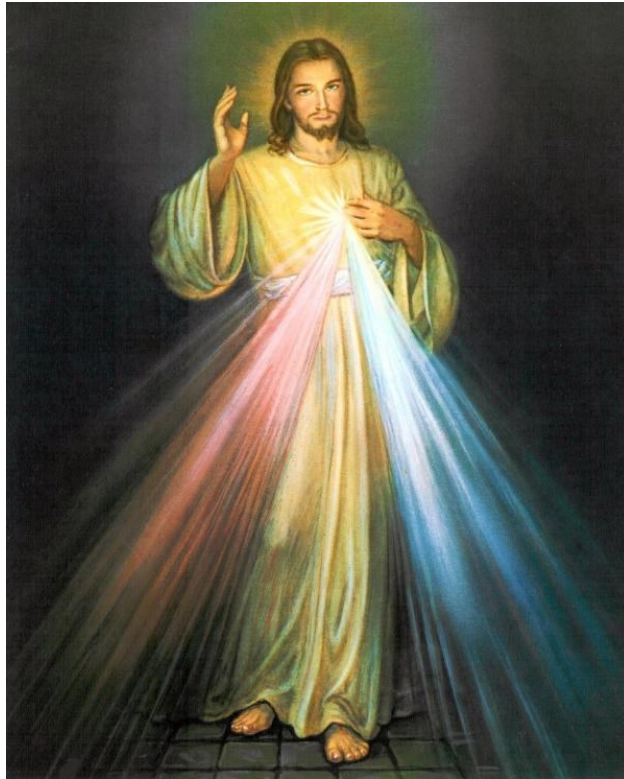

**HAND CARVED in BETHLEHEM**

**PLEASE STOP BY THE TABLES OF RELIGIOUS WARES (Nativity set, rosaries, statues, crucifixes, charms, etc.) AFTER ALL THE MASSES THE WEEKEND OF (May 13 & 14).**

Ayman Khair is representing about 180 Christian families from Bethlehem. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East and the Pandemic, tourism has been stopped completely from March 2, 2020 till February 2022 and it is very slow now.

It is very important to support them at this critical time since they have no income and there is no government to take care of them and help them. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United State to purchase their articles.

These **hand carved religious articles are beyond description.** Carved from **wood of the sacred Olive tree**, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income are able to stay living and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support.
