

DID YOU KNOW.....

that there has been a very wonderful response to the restoration of reception of the Precious Blood at Masses? After two and a half years of restricted access, we have been quickly retraining our Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist. Once again, we are SO very grateful for our "EM's"! Those who volunteer for this vital Ministry – whether helping the distribute Holy Communion at Mass, bringing Holy Communion to our home-bound parishioners, giving Holy Communion to Catholics (and their families) in the Hospital or Assisted Living Centers – are an extremely important part of our Parish Life!

The beautiful personal devotion of our Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist to our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament is itself inspiring to all of us. Their obvious love for our Lord in the Eucharist creates a beautiful aura of devotion and reverence around the reception of Holy Communion!

Being entrusted with the Body of Christ (or the Blood of Christ, at Mass) is a tremendous responsibility, and also, as our faithful EM's can tell you, a huge blessing!

While this is a Parish Ministry and an EM can only 'function' within their own parish, it is also a Diocesan Ministry – EM's must be approved for this service by the pastor, but also are specially recognized and appointed to this Ministry by our Bishop!

IF you feel that the Lord may be calling you to this Ministry, please contact *Deacon Bill Polakowski* here in our Parish Office, (458-2925) to begin the process!

The 'visits' which our EM's make to our own parishioners (and others in various institutions, nursing homes, Hospital) are a beautiful expression of the care and loving concern of the Church for all of her children.

One of the forms of blessing of EM's at the conclusion of the weekday Masses, speaks of this tremendous responsibly and blessed service: "You bear in your hands the Body of our Lord JESUS Christ. Bear Him also in your heart and in your life, that those you are going to will know that the Lord comes to them in their need, with healing, with life, and with love." Pray for our EM's, those they visit and serve, and consider

whether the Lord may be calling you to this Ministry!

And, again, a reminder that the doctrine of concomitance teaches that the whole Christ is present under each Eucharistic species. Christ is indivisible, so His body cannot be separated from His blood, His human soul, His divine nature, and His divine personality. Consequently, Christ is wholly present in the Sacred Host AND the Precious Blood. If you receive 'only' the Sacred Host, you receive the 'whole Christ': Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. If you receive 'only' the Precious Blood, you receive the 'whole Christ': Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity!

And, reception by intinction, the 'dipping' of the Sacred Host into the Precious Blood, is reserved to the clergy, because it takes place on the altar, with the linens in place, to protect against accidental dripping. It is not appropriate for a communicant to receive the Sacred Host and carry it to a chalice and 'self-communicate' by intinction - dipping it into the Precious Blood.





CATHOLIC QUIZ: This Week's Question: "What is the 'Camino'?"



The Answer to Last Week's Question: "Where is Adam's grave?" The Holy Land has many holy places, but none so venerable as the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in Jerusalem. This favorite place of pilgrimage has many chapels, and one of them, the "Chapel of Adam" is located directly under the remaining rock of Calvary. It is so called in tradition, relates St. Jerome and others, because it was believed that Christ was crucified on the very spot that Adam was buried, so that the redeeming Blood of the Saviour poured down upon humankind's first guilty head. The skull and crossed bones that appear occasionally on crucifixes are a remnant of this legend. Whatever there is to this, "Golgotha" is a fitting name for this holy hill, resembling a skull, on which the New Adam paid the price for sin!
