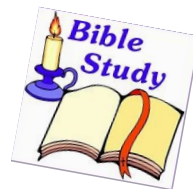

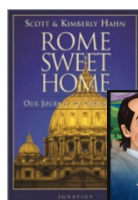

DID YOU KNOW.....

that as we welcome more and more of our parishioners (and visitors) back to worship, it is very important that we all become “ministers of hospitality”?

It is not just our wonderful cadre of volunteer ministers of hospitality (ushers and greeters), who are ‘ministers of first impressions’ – but each one of us is called to show hospitality to others! The welcoming smile, the ‘good morning’ or ‘good evening’, the moving over to make room in the pew, do not “interfere” with the worship of God’s People, these all enhance worship. With the requirements of masking and social distancing, we all have had to make an ‘extra mile’ effort to connect with others – whenever we are out of our homes. Our practice at St. Andrew’s/Good Shepherd is to encourage such quiet greetings, and although we are discouraged from shaking hands, those who are preparing for Mass should acknowledge the presence of those around them in some way. We are, after all ‘brothers and sisters in the Lord.’ Following the announcements before Mass, there is a period of silence and focusing, before the Processional begins the celebration of the Mass.

Admittedly, not all parishes follow this particular pattern - each parish is unique in its makeup and expression of itself – just like any family, but this approach allows us to welcome one another – as brothers and sisters – and then, quietly, began our personal, prayerful preparation to enter into the Presence through the ‘gate of the Mass.’

When it comes to welcoming visitors, there is actually a Scriptural mandate involved:

“Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for by doing that some have entertained angels without knowing it.”

(Hebrews 13:2)

Our visitors are never an ‘intrusion’ on one’s worship, even if we have to make room for them in “our pew”! The following story, entitled “The Visitor,” may be instructive: “One day a man went to visit a church. He arrived early, parked his car and got out. Another car pulled up near him and the driver told him, ‘I always park there. You took my place!’ He made his way into the church, and sat down. Another parishioner walked up to him and said, “That’s where we always sit. You took our place!” He seemed befuddled, walked up into the sanctuary, and sat in the Celebrant’s chair! The priest quietly explained that the visitor would have to return to one of the pews, because, he said, ‘You took my place!’ Later, as the parishioners prayed, welcoming the Eucharistic Lord to dwell with them, the visitor stood, and his appearance began to change. Horrible scars appeared on his hands and on his sandaled feet. He turned and said to them, “I took your place.” Yes, we welcome one another in the Name of the One ‘Who took our place’!

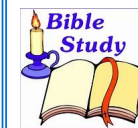

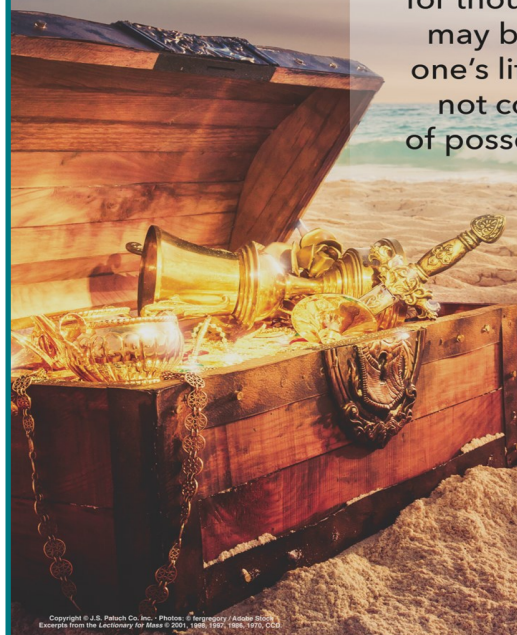

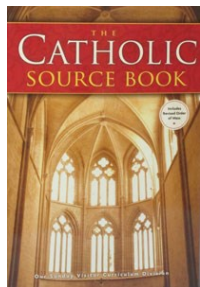

CATHOLIC QUIZ: *"This week's Question: 'What are the 'Tears of Saint Lawrence'?"*

The answer to last week's Question: "Who are the 'Fathers of the Church'?"



This term designates the theologians and writers of the first eight centuries, eminent in holiness and learning, called – collectively – ‘*Fathers of the Church*’. Their authoritative witnesses to the belief and teaching of the Church and their unanimous acceptance of key doctrines as divinely revealed has been regarded as the evidence that these doctrines were received by the Church consistent with Apostolic Tradition and the Sacred Scriptures, under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit! Their unanimous rejection of certain doctrines branded those ideas as heretical. (*John 14:16-17* speaks of this guidance by the Holy Spirit, promised by our Lord to His Apostles, and through them, to the Church!)

SOUL FOOD:

"We call this food Eucharist, and no one is permitted to partake of it, except one who believes our teaching to be true, who has been baptized, and who is living as Christ commanded. St. Andrew the Apostle Parish Monthly Council Meeting July 19th, 2022

Linda K. called the meeting to order at 5:35 p.m. and Fr. Greg led the group in an opening prayer.

Minutes from the June 2022 meeting were approved as written.

Finance (Kate): Income for June was \$72,230 of which \$855 were designated to Good Shepherd Mission. Expenses were \$75,958. The Parish general fund level is \$571,526. The Building Our Church fund balance is \$109,661.

St. Vincent de Paul Society (Pauline): Bids received for the parking lot on the east side of the Conference building were too high to be cost effective, so the project has been shelved for the time being. The Legacy Foundation awarded a grant for utilities and State Representative Gail Griffin made a large personal donation to the Conference out of concern for the store closure loss of revenue. Comfort Inn made a large donation of furnishings as they are refurbishing their rooms on their property. The Thrift Store should be open in mid-August. The Food Bank donations were lower last month, but demand has grown. 45 to 50 families per day are being served. Over 900 food boxes were distributed last month. Kate Polakowski will be recognized with a special gift in gratitude for her selfless giving to St. Vincent de Paul Conference Activities.

Our Lady of the Sierras (Charlie): Monica Garcia, the new Executive Director has assumed her full time responsibilities. Fr. Jude Dioka will be assisting at the shrine.

Knights of Columbus and St. Paul Street Evangelization (Ed): A group of Knights just finished putting down a new floor upstairs in the Columbian Hall. Their first of a new monthly Adoration session was held in the Divine Mercy Chapel last week. Some Knights are helping clean and repaint the Rectory in Willcox, Fr. Ramonito's new assignment. The Saint Paul Street Evangelization booth had a lot of visitors during the 4th of July celebration and distributed literature and miraculous medals. There will be a public Rosary on Saturday the 23rd in front of Chili's.

Building and Grounds (Maryann): Repairs will be made on weak spots on the bell tower floor. Mark Williams has designed a system to repair the faulty valves on the irrigation system. Maintenance staff have developed a process to make the flooring in Madonna Hall look new. The Kino Hall HVAC system replacement has been delayed until the beginning of 2023. Parts are not expected to be in until November; however, there are too many activities in the building during November and December. The refrigerator in Kino Hall has failed. Parts to repair are not available so a new refrigerator will be purchased.

The Community Food Bank will be the beneficiary of the free will offering for this year's Hymn Fest.

Pastor's Report (Fr Greg): Fr. Greg asked for support for the Community Food Bank that truly supports the working poor in the community.

Linda adjourned the meeting at 6:20 p.m. and Fr. Greg led the group in a closing prayer.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I wish to inform you that we have discovered a suspended and inactive priest (Jeffrey Newell) currently residing in the Willcox area. Allegations of sexual misconduct with a minor in two dioceses outside of Arizona resulted in his suspension and removal from priestly ministry by the Archbishop of Los Angeles. His suspension from ministry has been upheld by the Vatican. Jeffrey Newell is listed on several internet web sites, including BishopAccountability.org, as being a person against whom credible allegations of sexual abuse of minors have been established.

If Jeffrey Newell presents himself to you or anyone else as a priest, please be aware that he has been suspended from the priesthood, is not in good standing, and has had credible allegations of misconduct reported against him, which he has admitted. 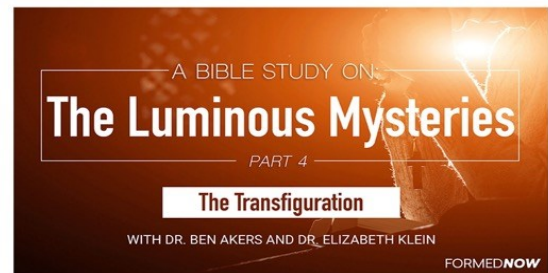

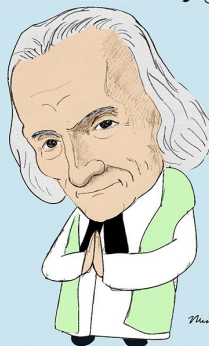
