

CATHOLIC QUIZ: This Week's Question: "Who, exactly, are the 'Three Kings'?"

The Answer to last week's Question: "What is the 'Gregorian' or 'New Style' Calendar?" By 1582 the calendar was reading March 11 at the time of the vernal equinox, which had occurred on March 25, when the Julian Calendar was established. On a solar calendar such annual and predictable solar phenomena (seasons) should have fallen on the same day every year, but Julius Caesar's calendar and nature were not in step. This is because his allotment of 365¼ days per year is eleven minutes and 10 seconds 'short' – the earth was revolving around the sun faster than Julius had calculated, (365.2422 and not 365.25), and, by 1582, the Julian Calendar was two weeks ahead of itself! In his reform of the calendar, Pope Gregory XII selected 21 March as the date of the vernal equinox, because that is when it was in the year of the Council of Nicea (325) AD), which fixed the dating of Easter. Then, on October 4, 1582, the Pope "suppressed" ten days, making 1582 the year that October 15 followed October 4. By the simple new formula, the same error was prevented from happening in the future (except for the one day every thirty-five centuries). At first, Protestant countries refused to use the *Gregorian Calendar*; it was adopted in England finally in 1752 (called the 'New Style' calendar), and in Russia in 1918! The Eastern Orthodox Churches continue to use the Julian Calendar, hence the different dates of Easter between the Orthodox and other Churches!


